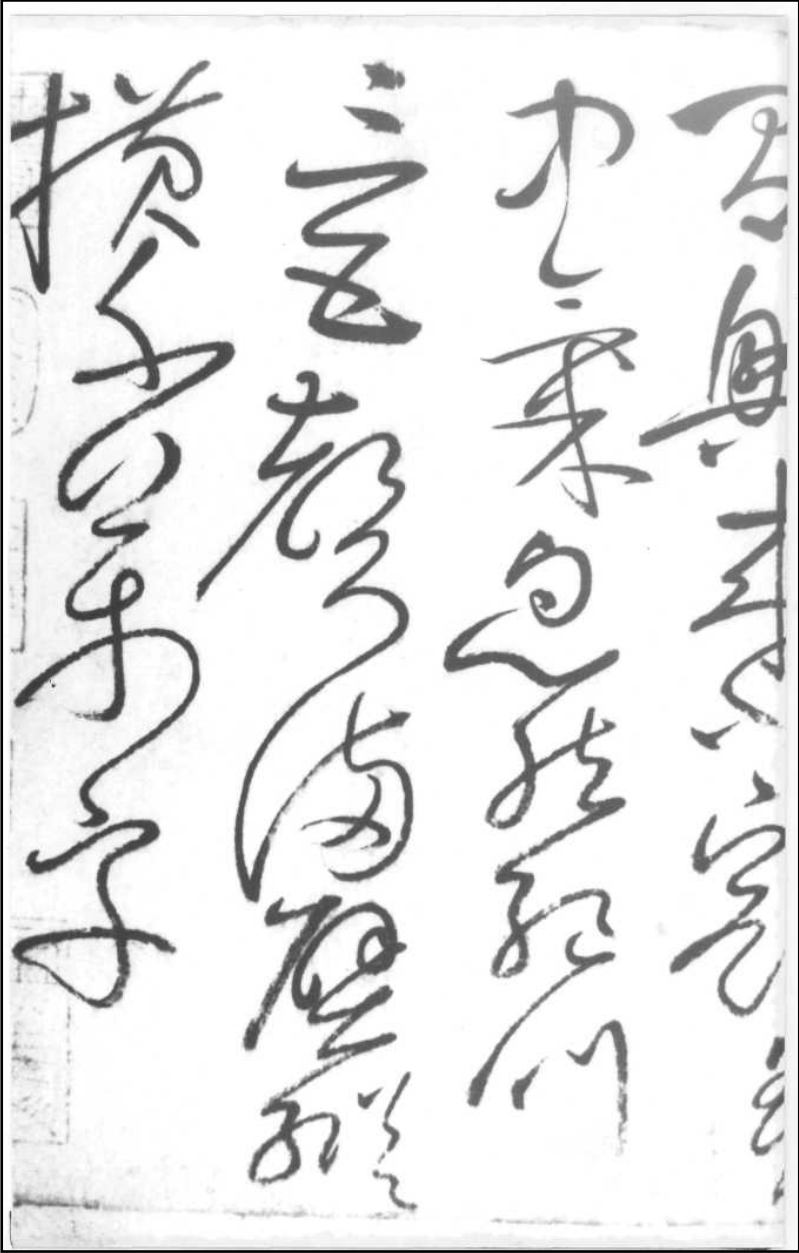

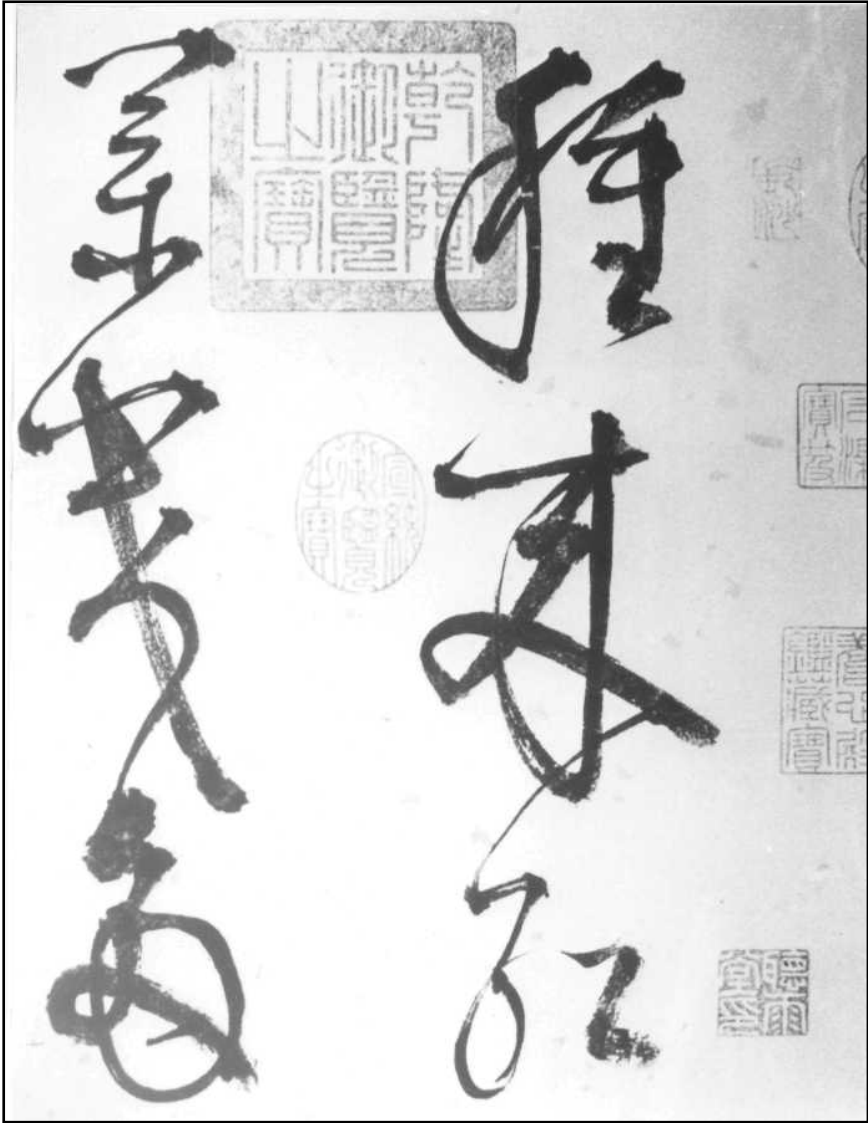
76-1. André Masson, *The Abyss*, 1955, 36 1/4 x 28 3/4",

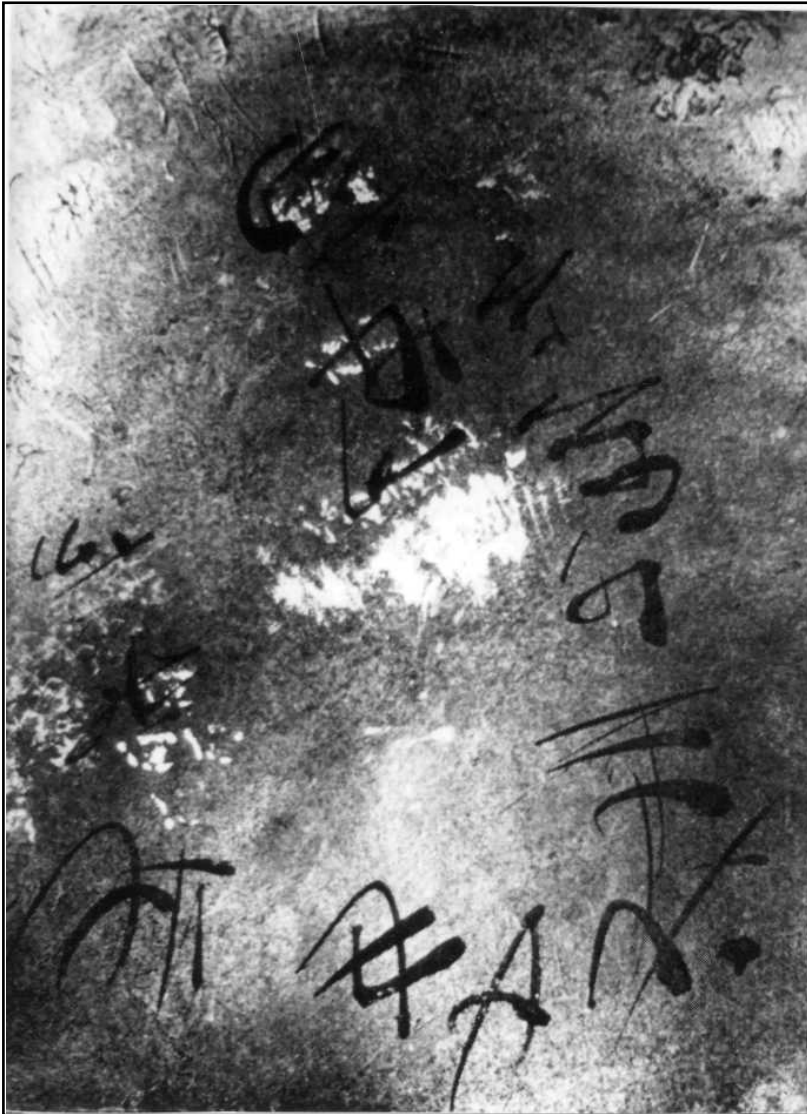
77. Huai Su (懷素), Autobiographic Essay (detail)



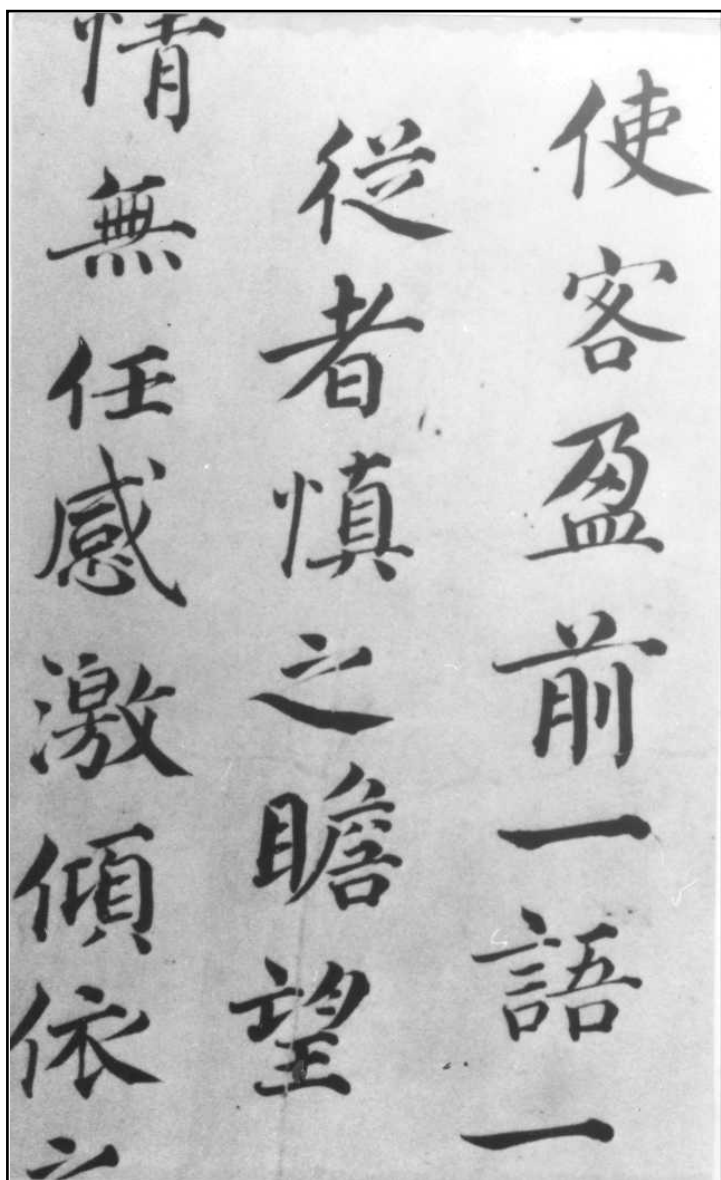

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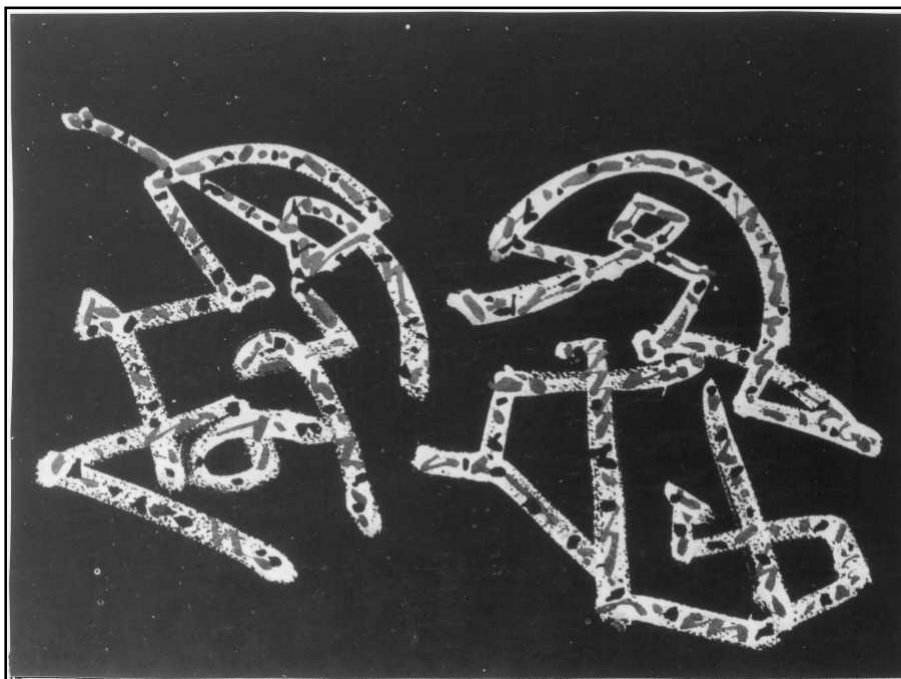

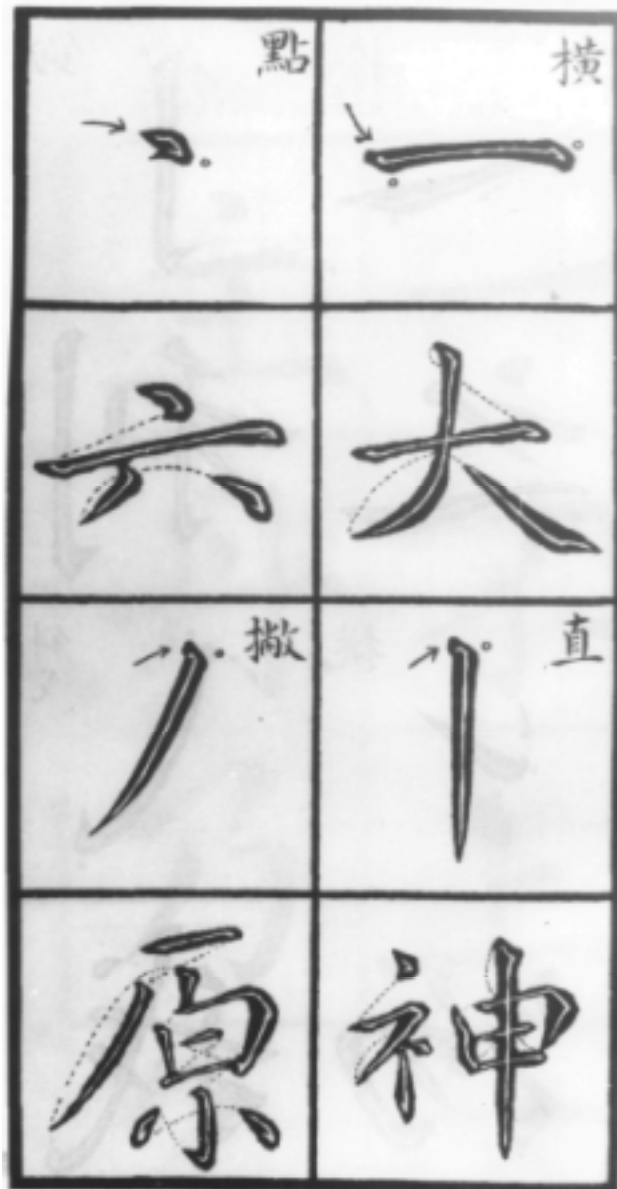

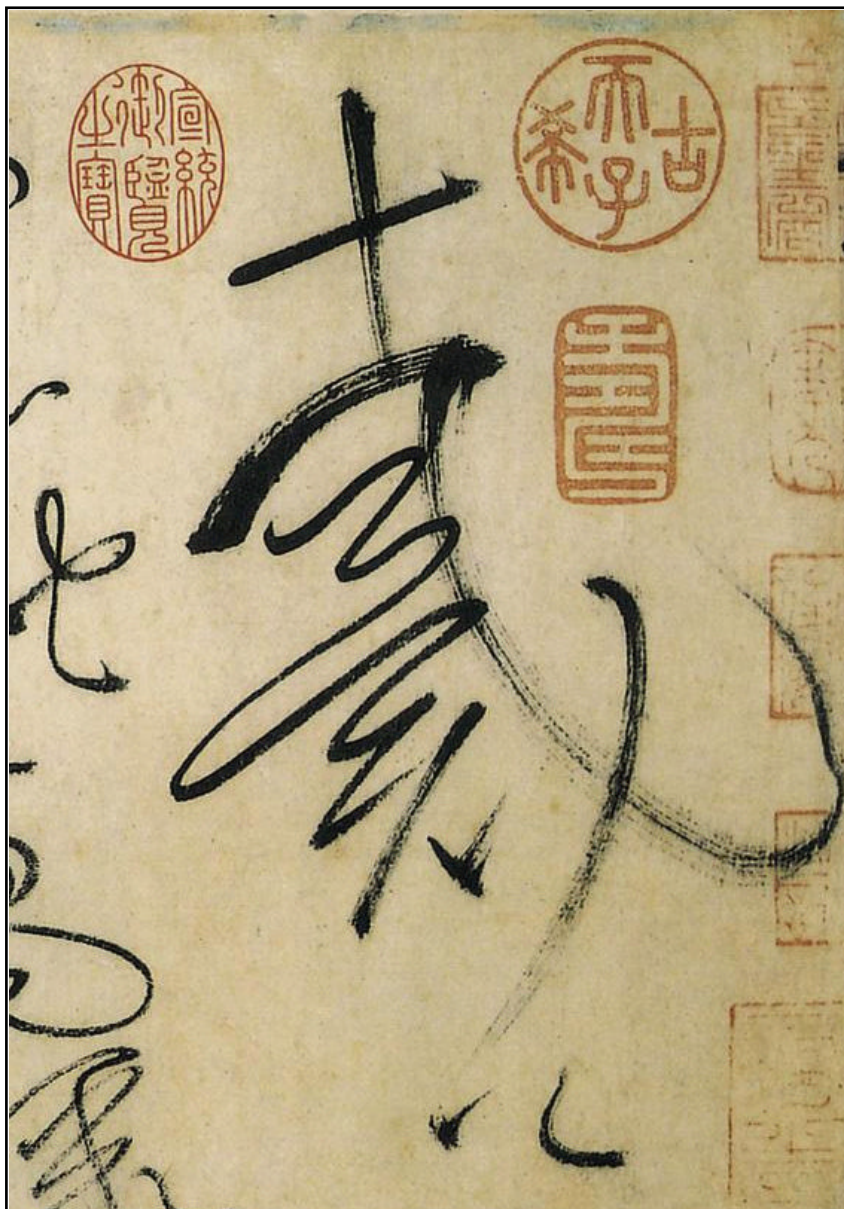
87. Characters in the Style of Wang Hsi-chih (王羲之);

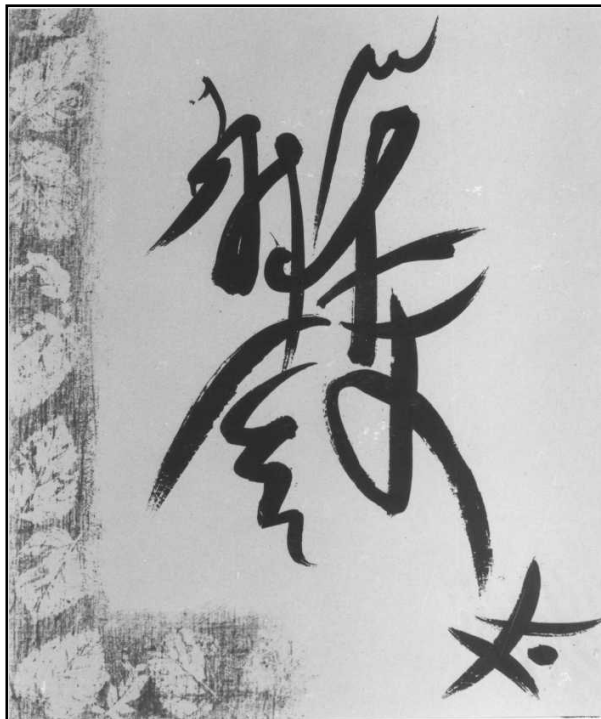


89. Sample-Script in the style of Kai-Shu, (楷書)  
with lines marking the trace of the brush tip

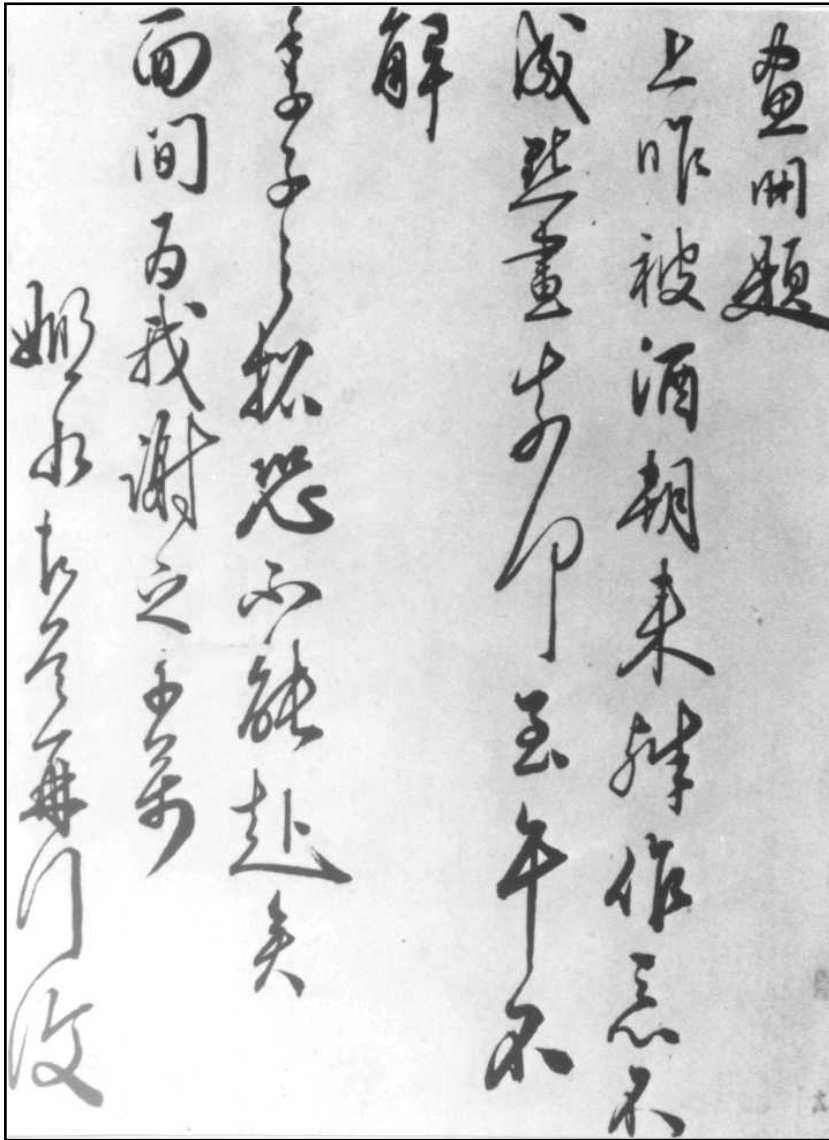

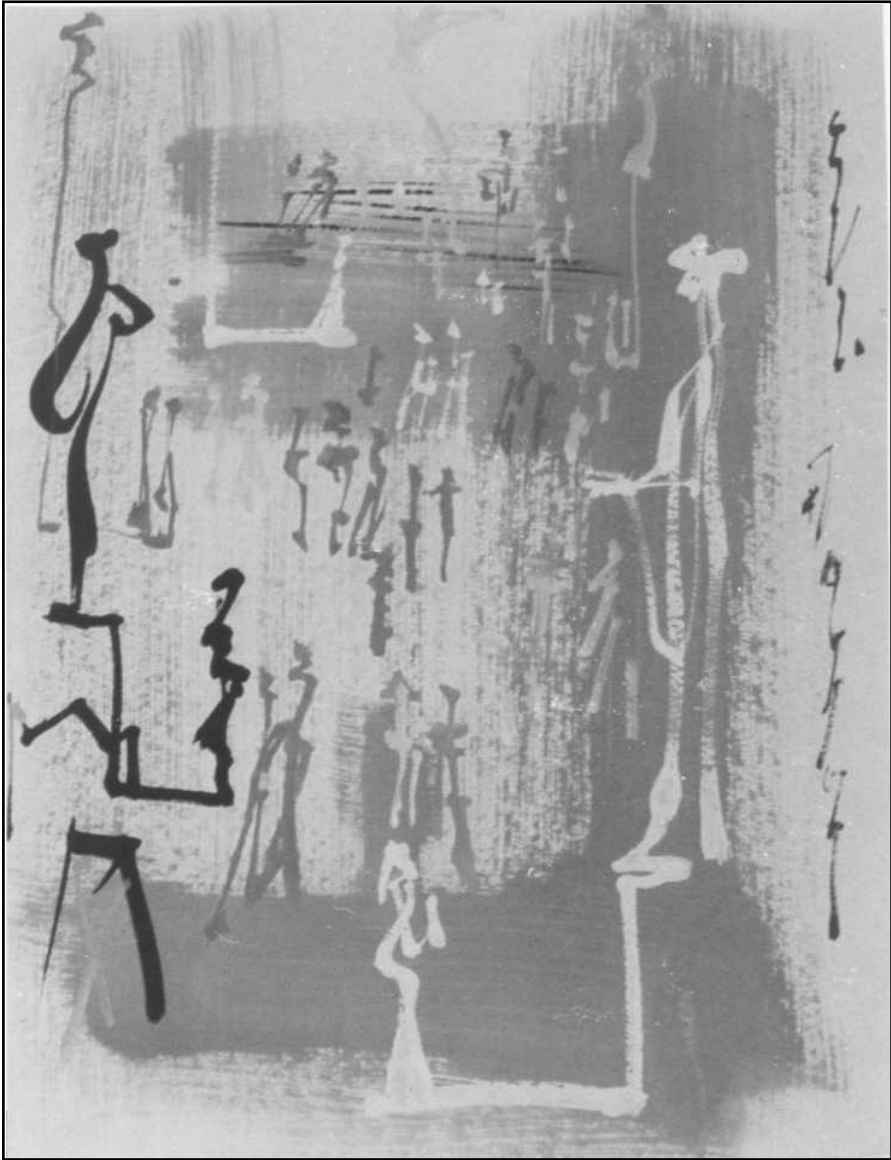

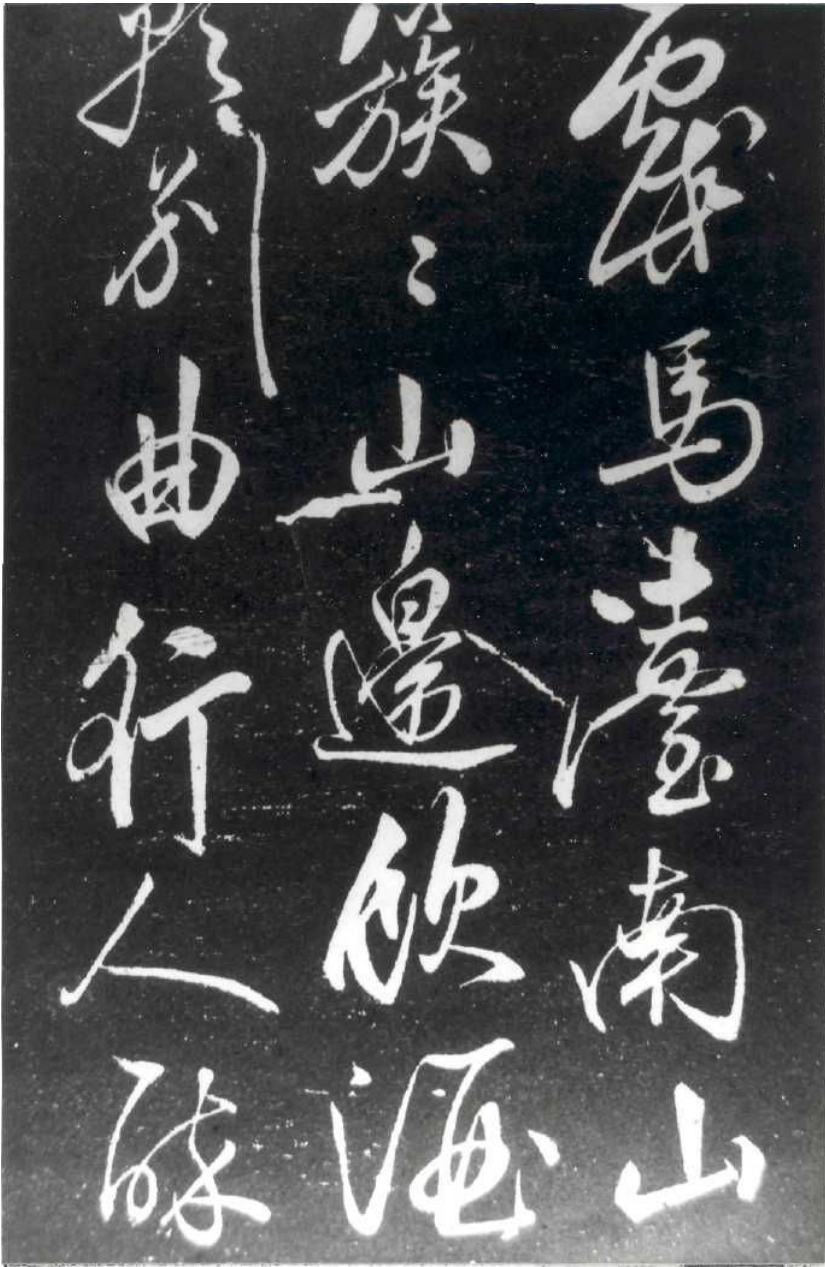




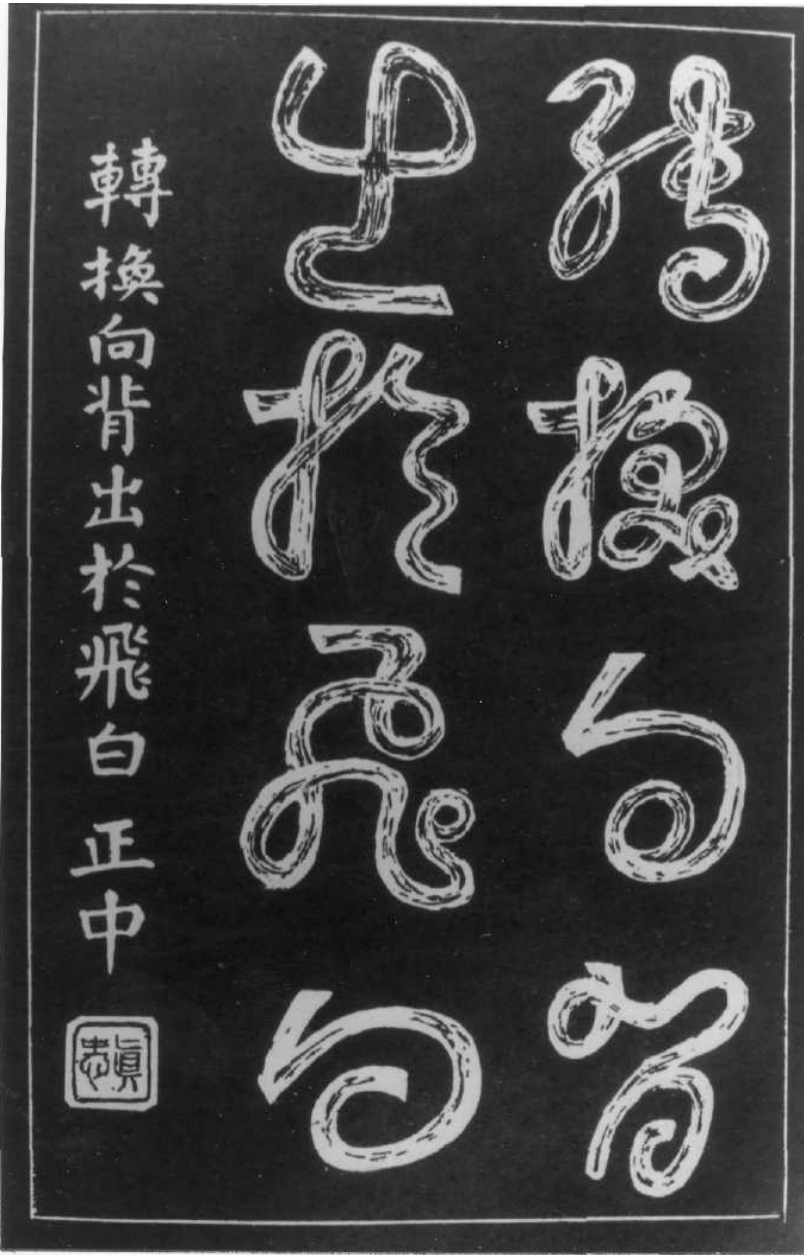

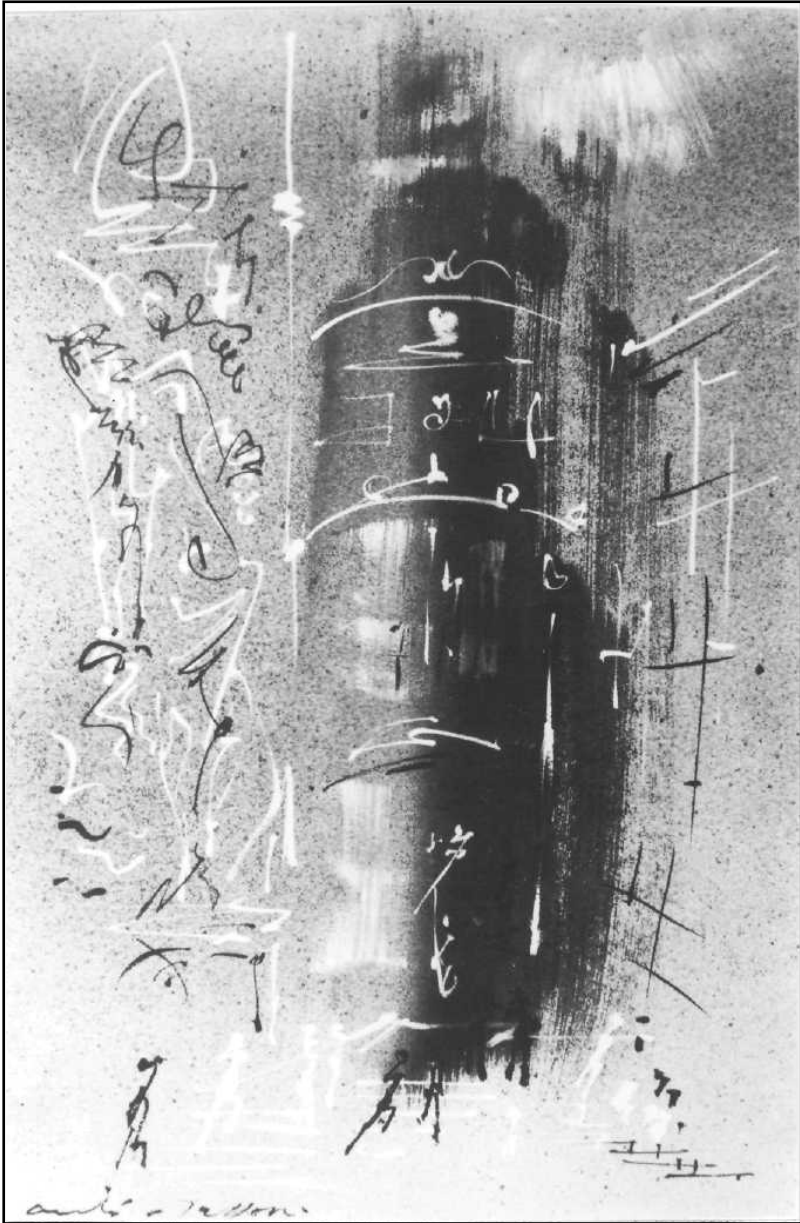

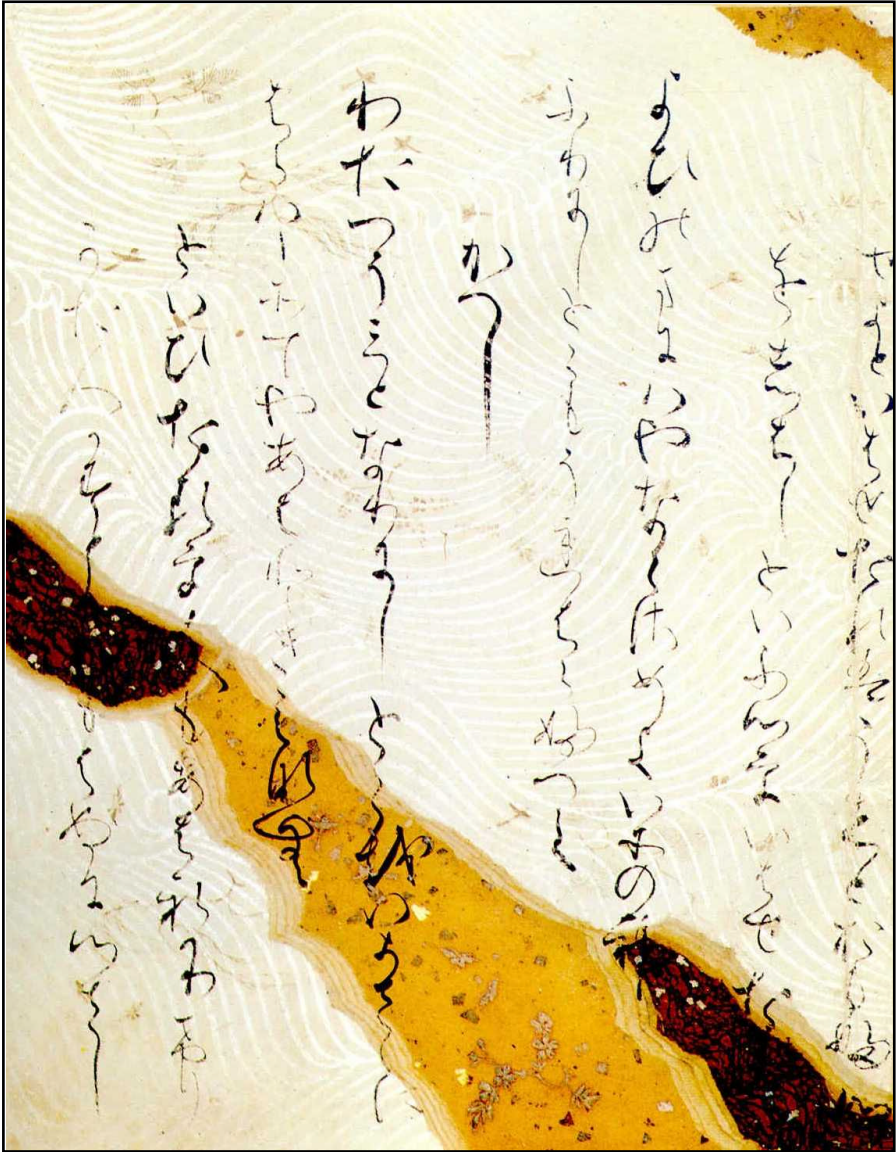
97. Shih Cheng-chung (史正中),

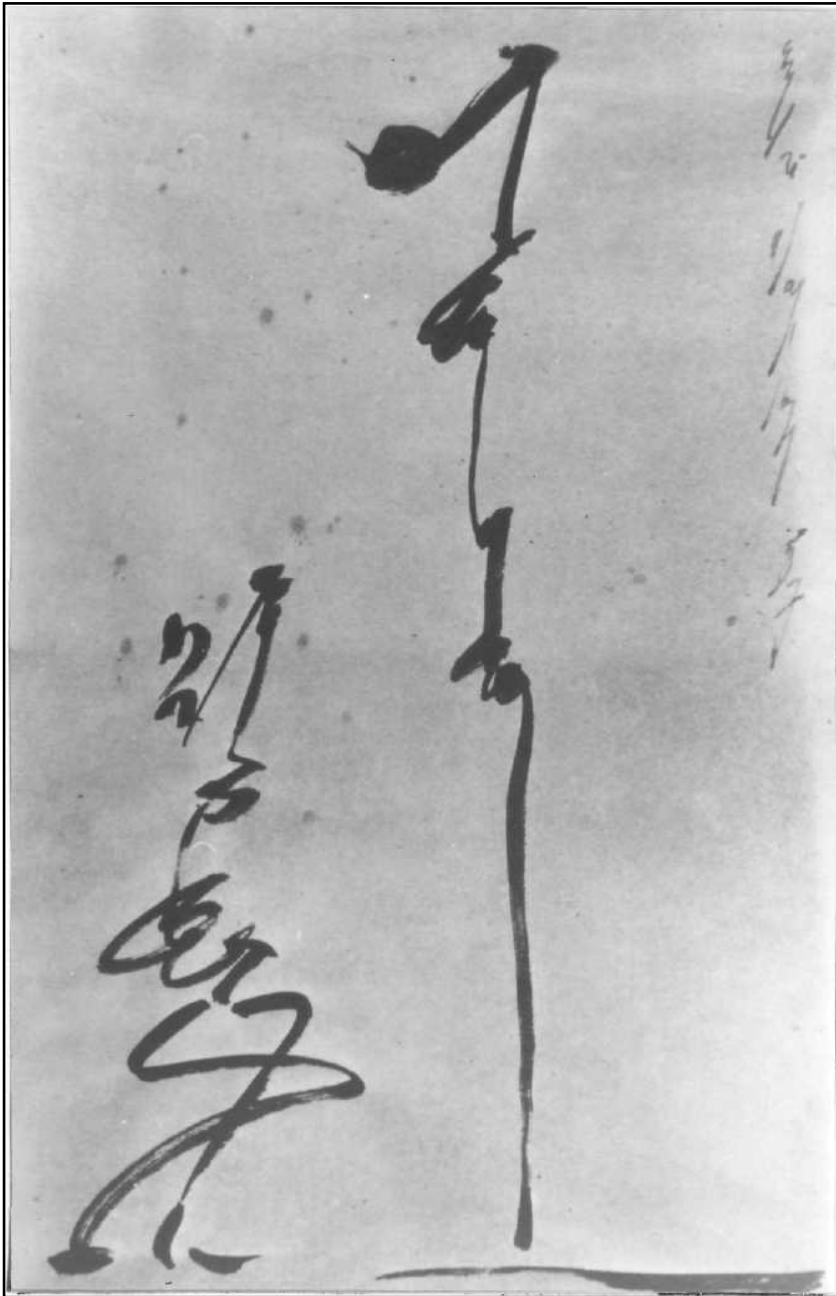

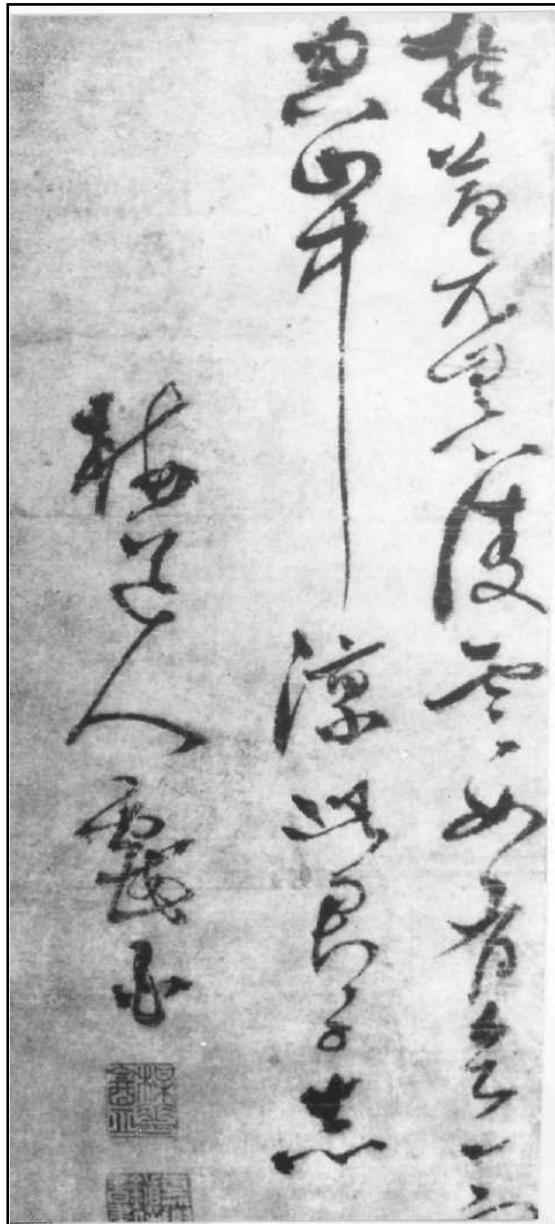

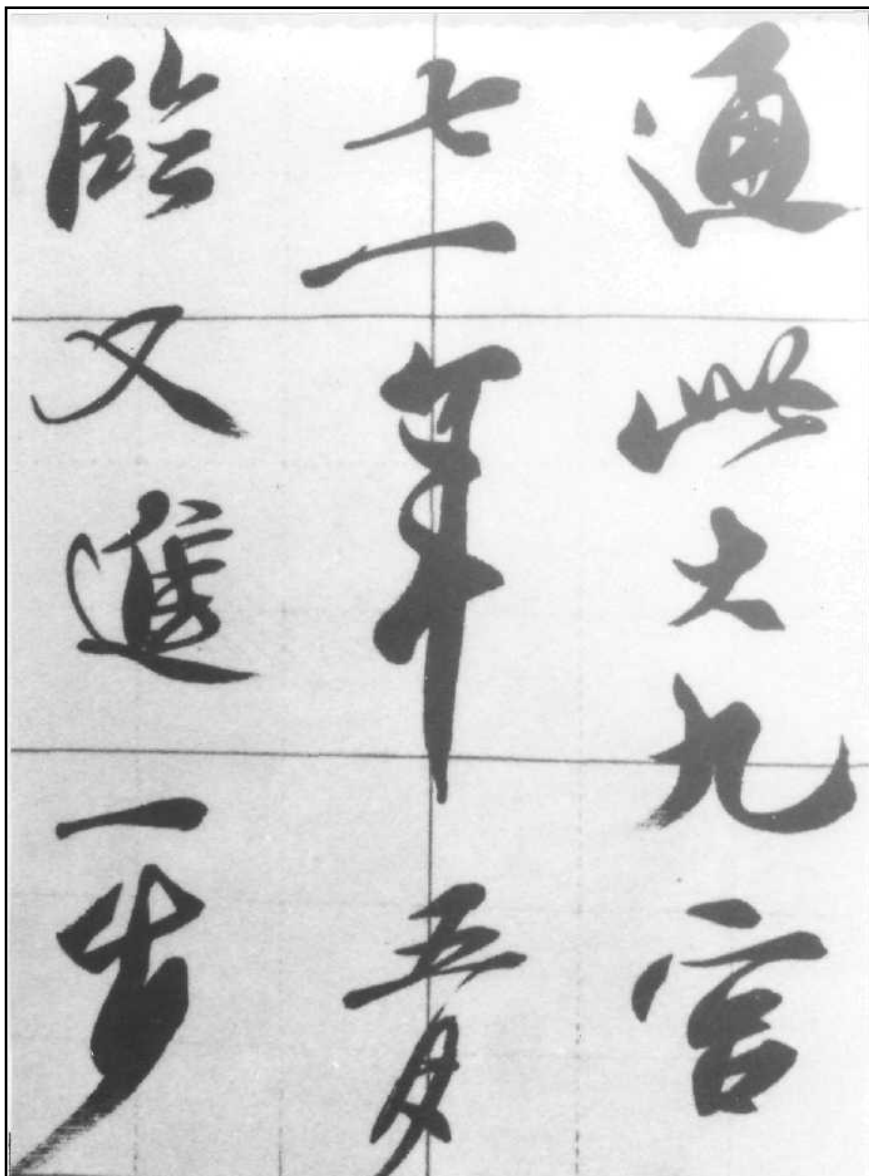


101. André Masson, *Suppliante*, 1937, Lavis/Ink,

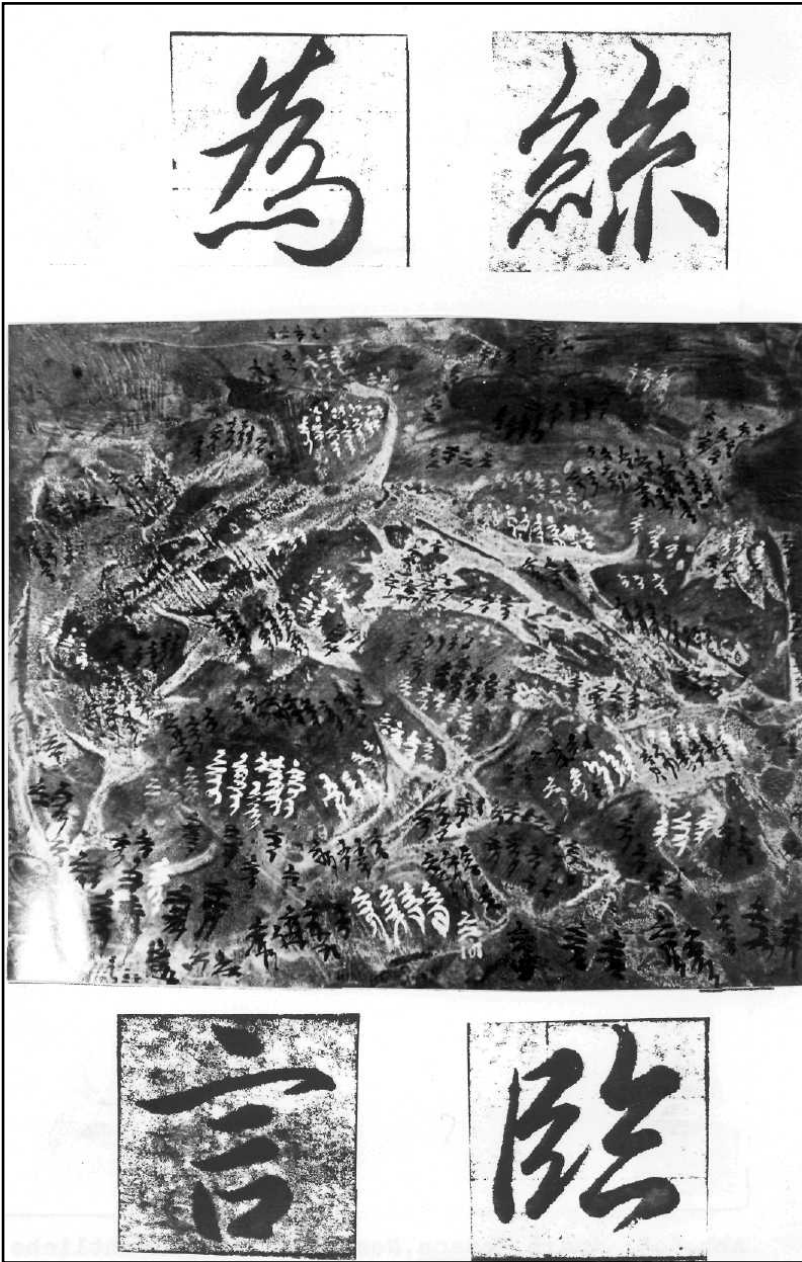

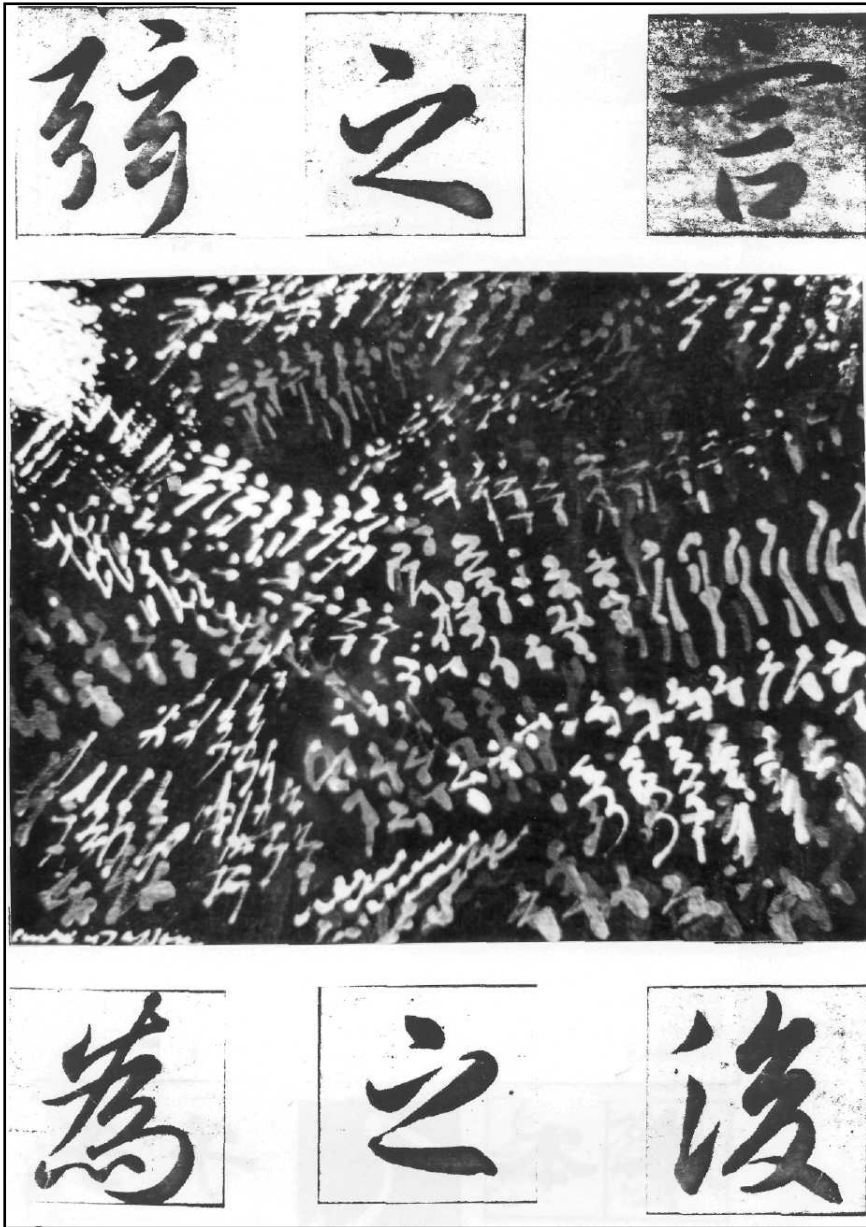

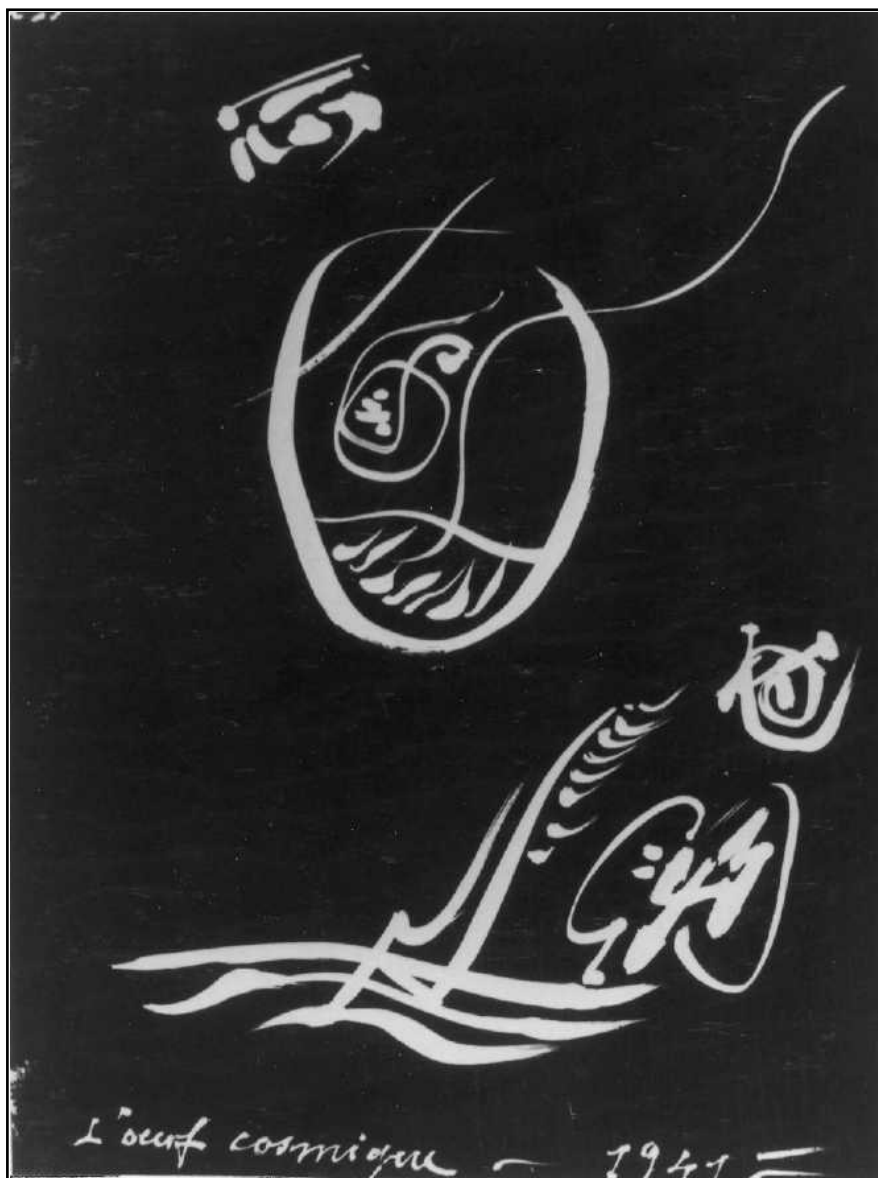

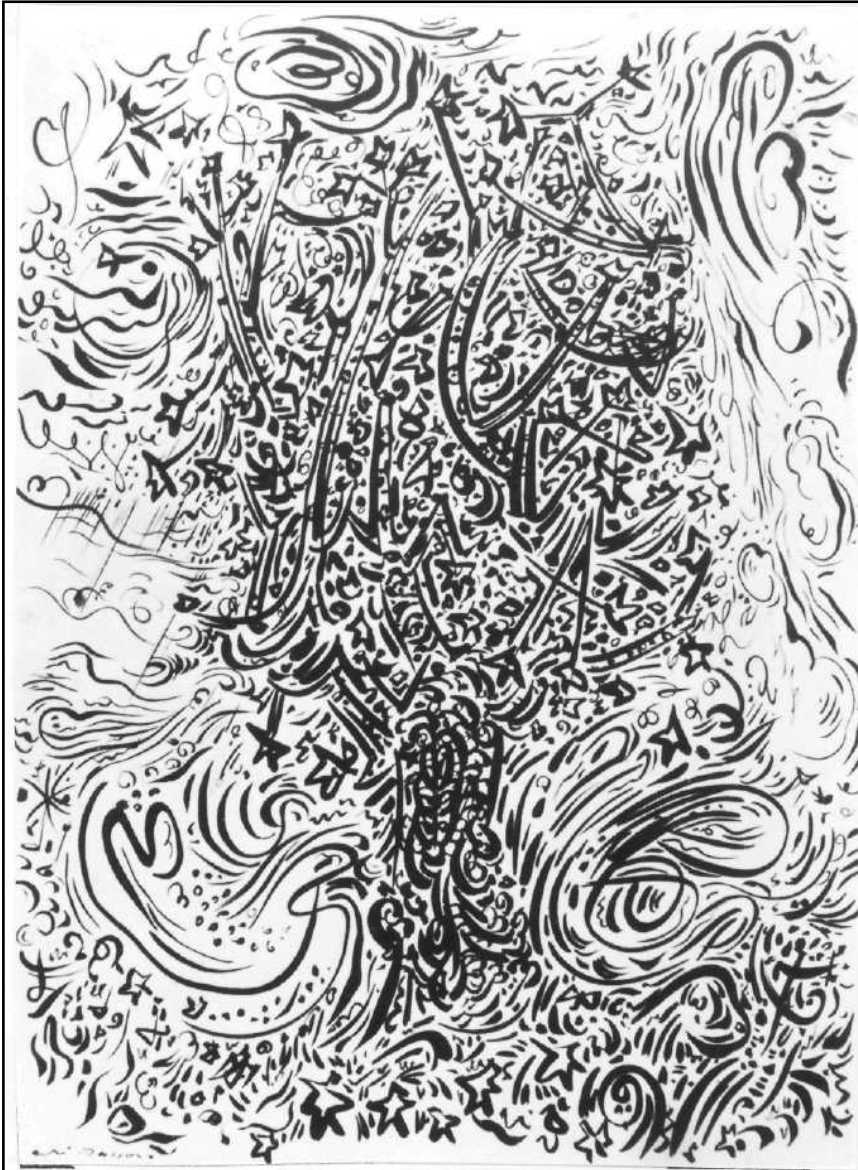


107. Li-Shu (隸書) - Kalligraphie,

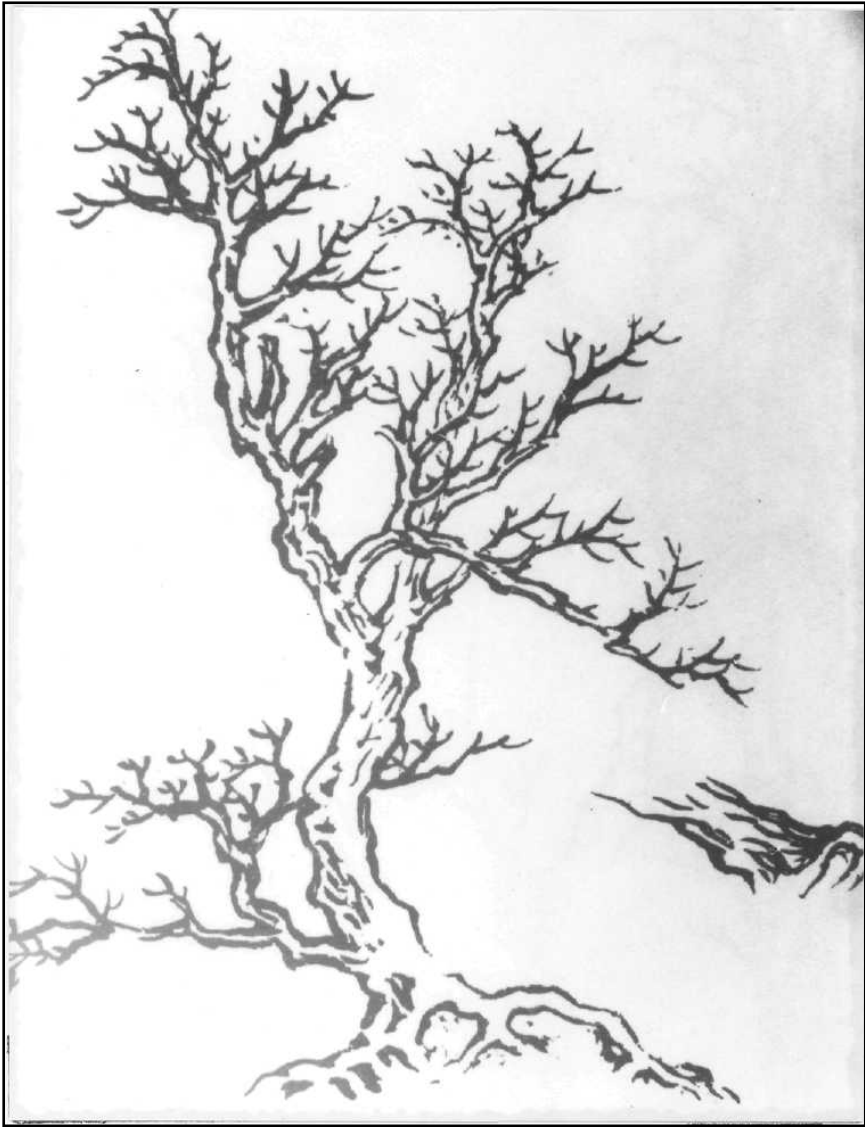


108. André Masson, L' Oeuf cosmique, 1941,  
Tempera, 31,2 x 23 cm

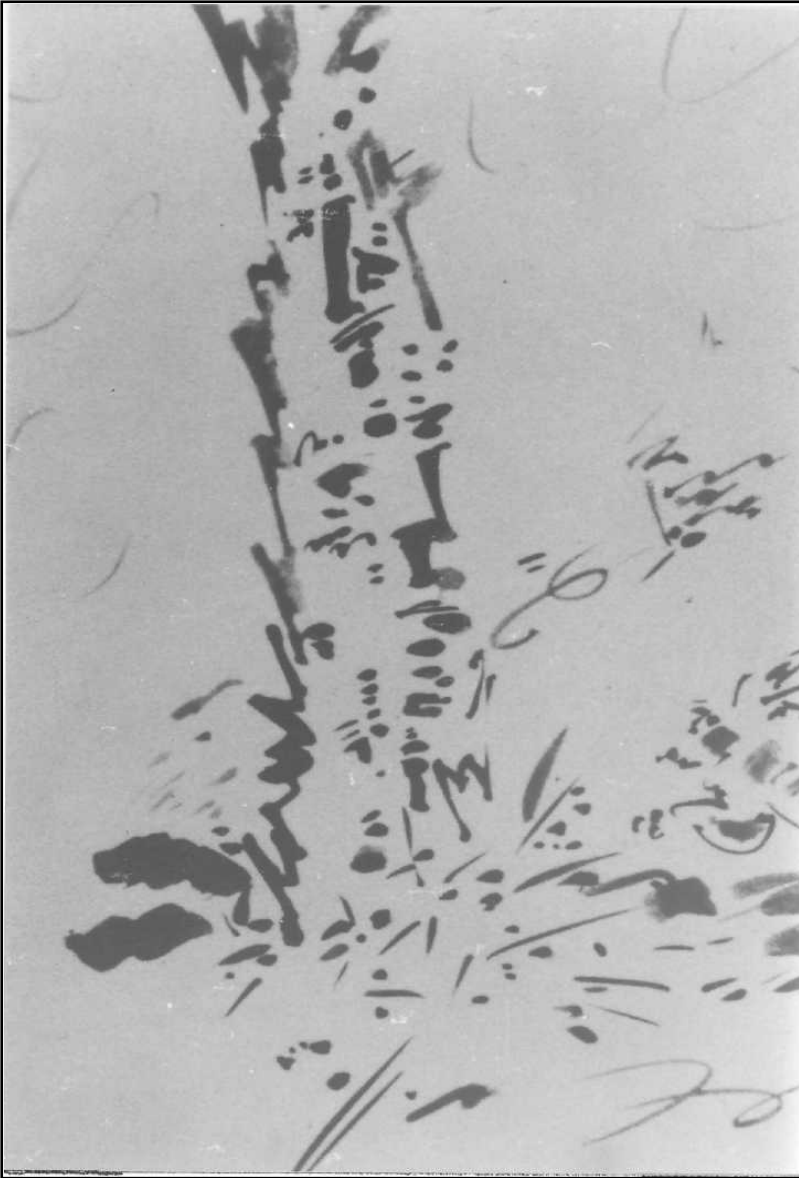

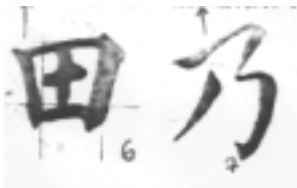

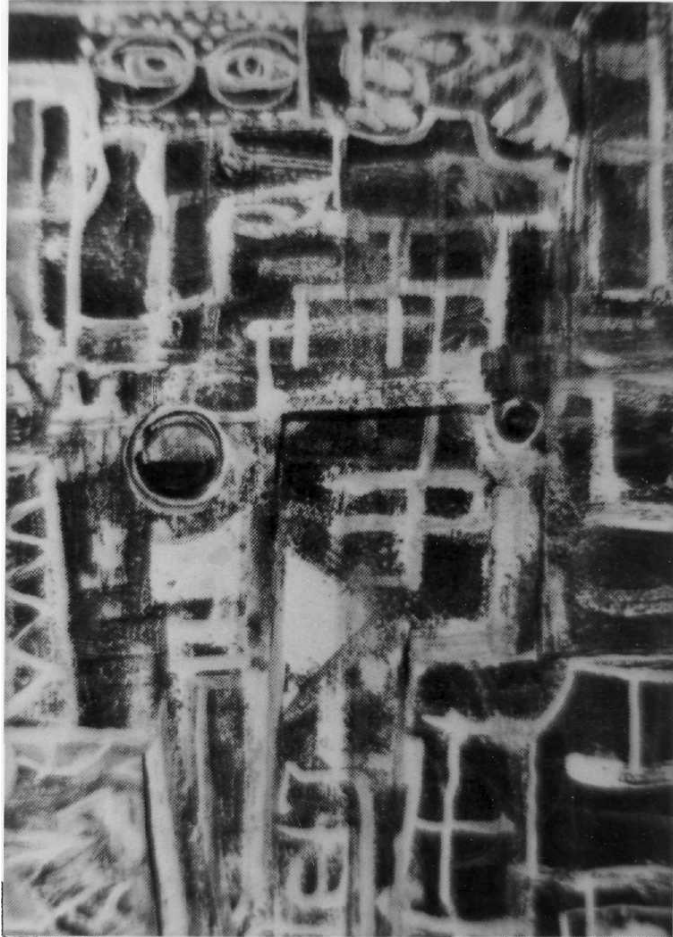
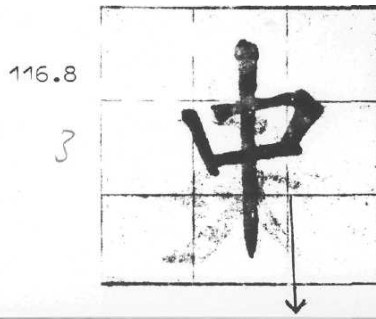

116.1 Mark Tobey, *Broadway*, 1956, (detail)

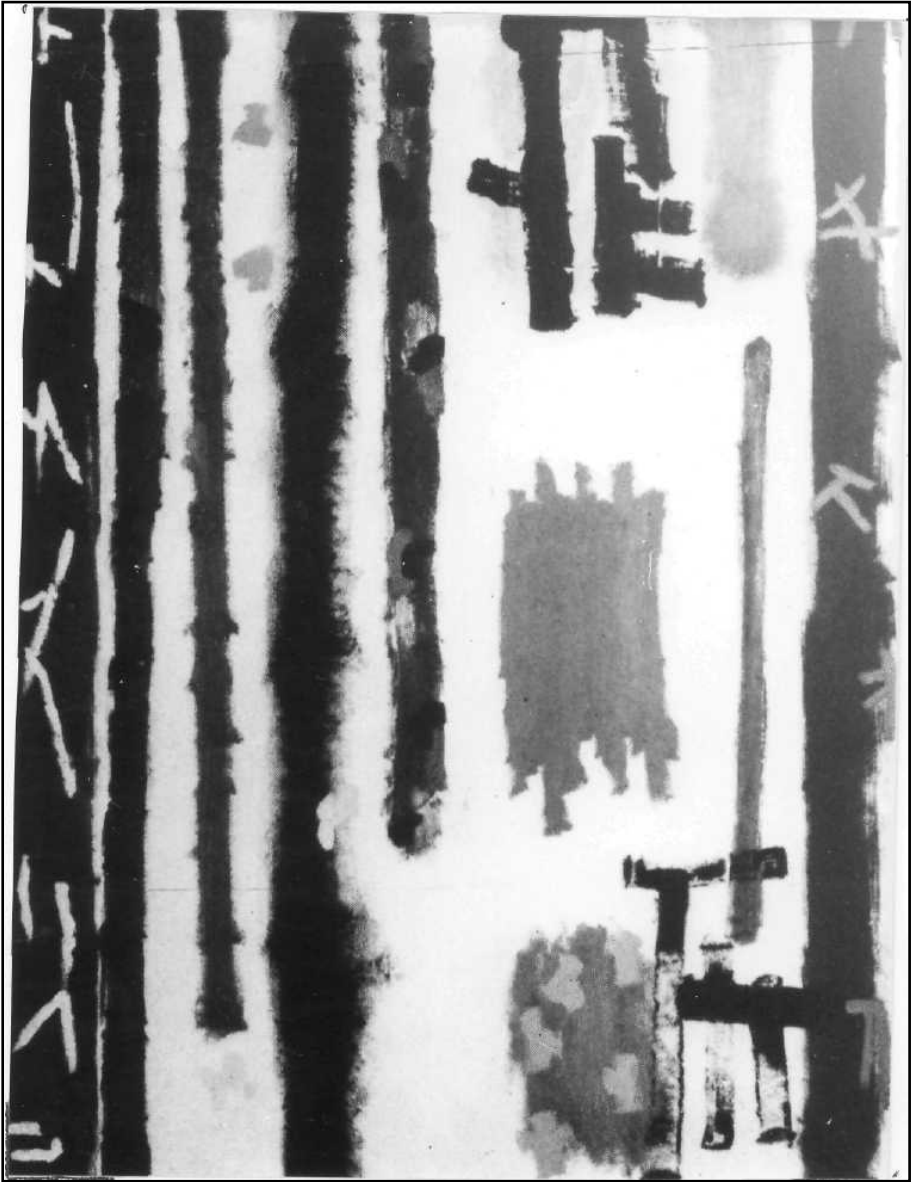

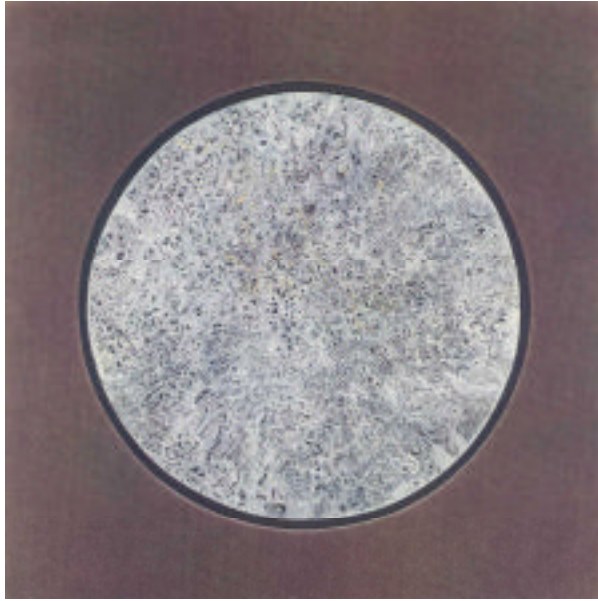

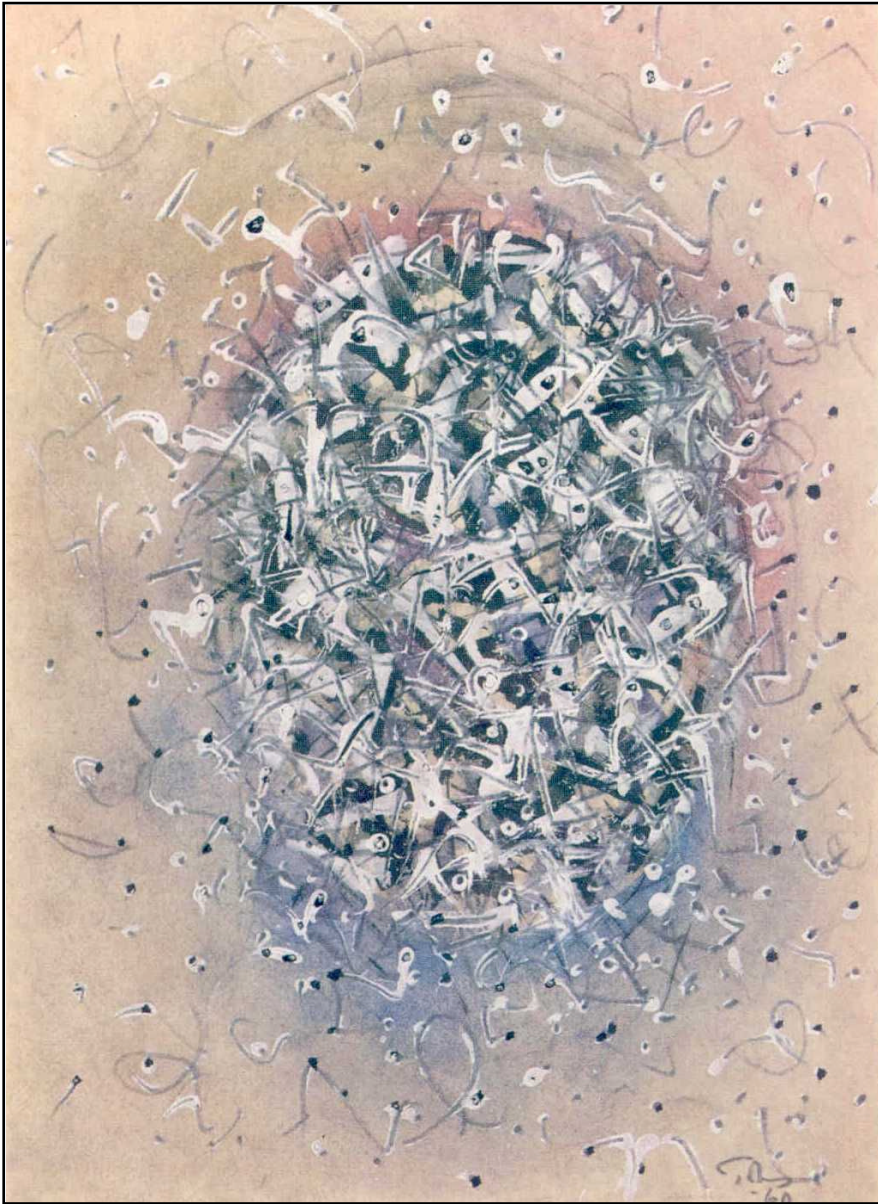

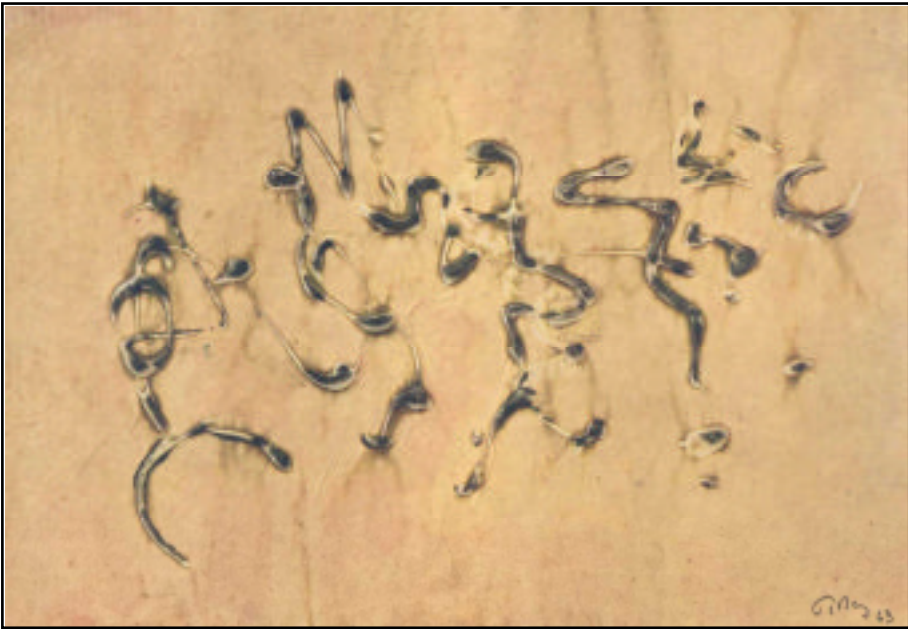
126. Small Seal Script (Hsiao-chuan 小篆)



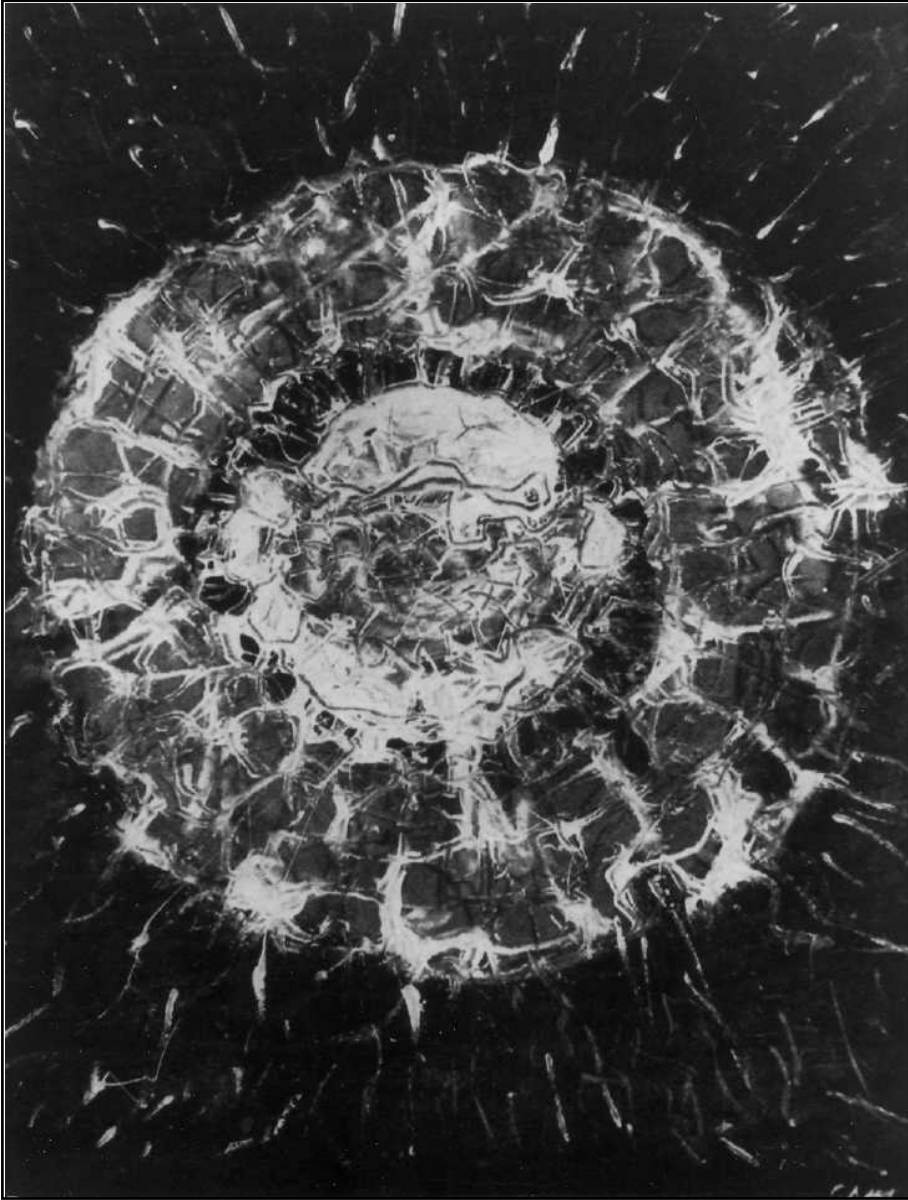

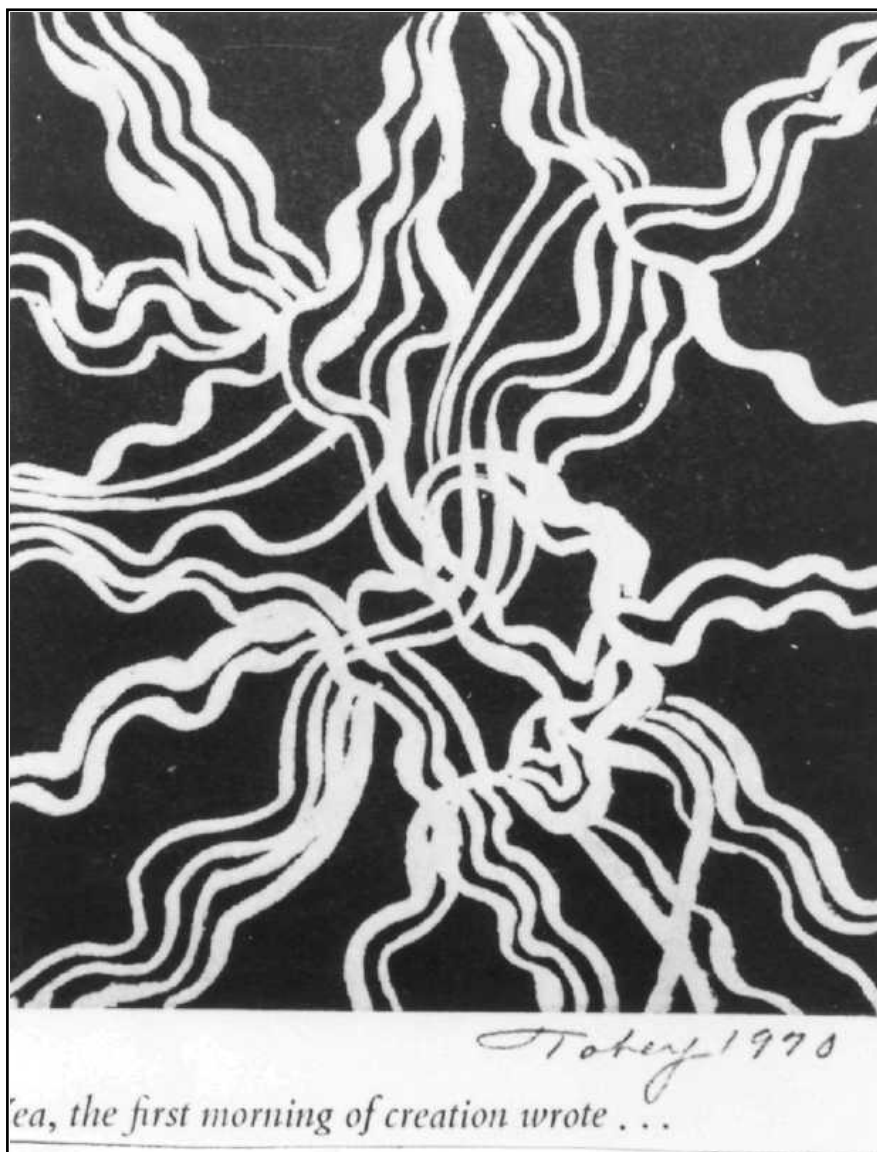


127. Mark Tobey, Calligraphic Dance, 1963,

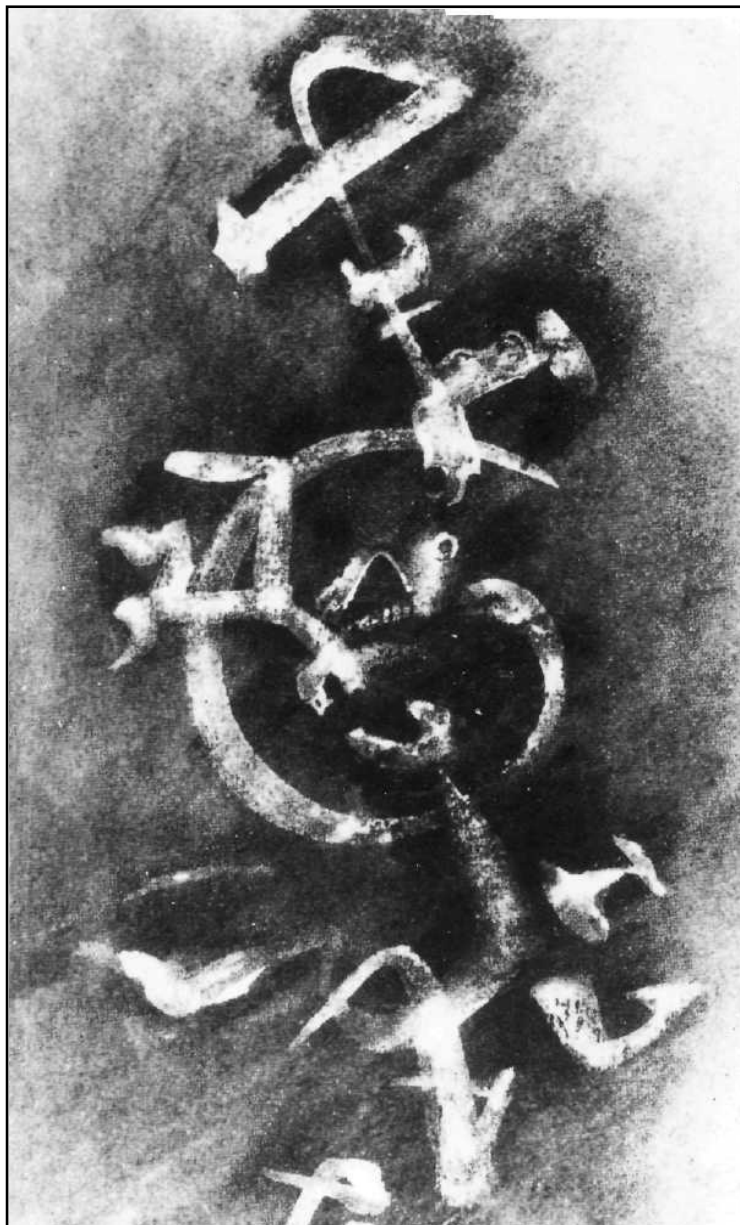

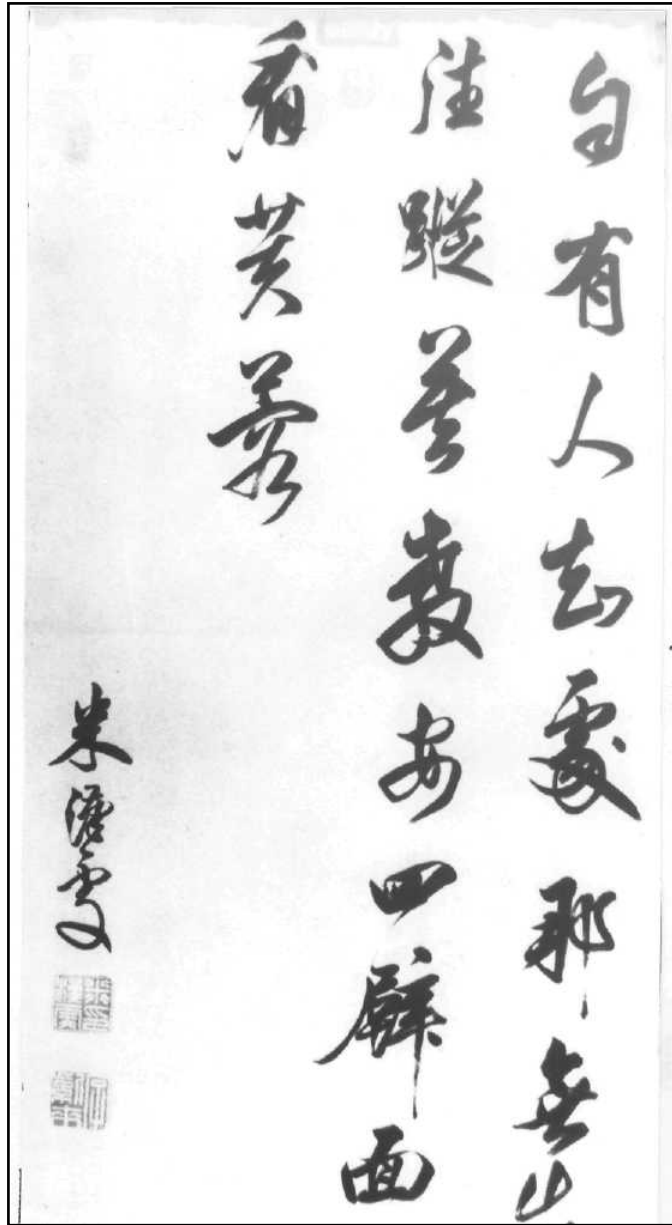

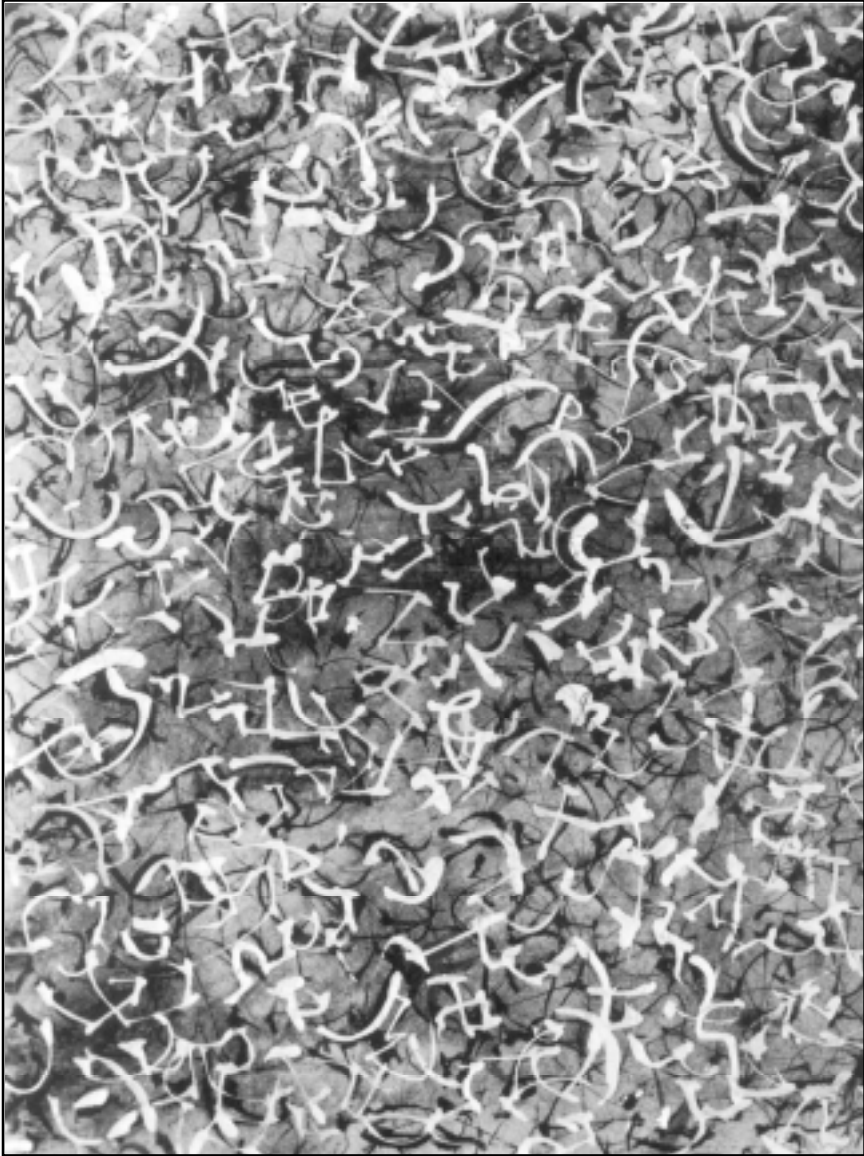

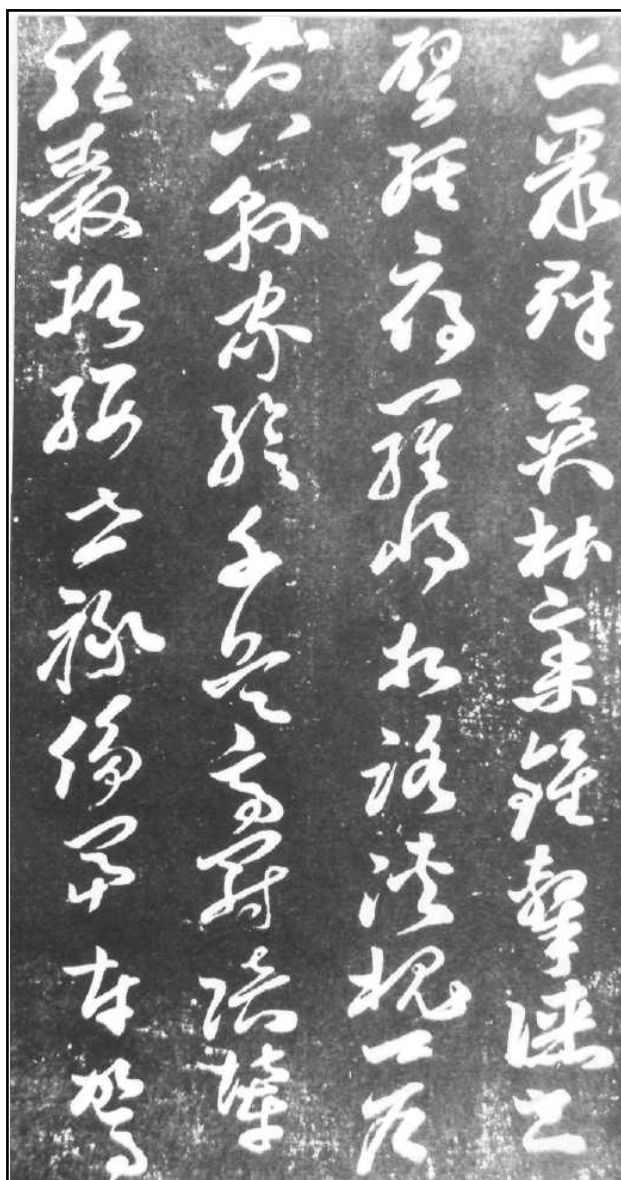


136. Mark Tobey, *The Void Devouring the Gadget Era*,

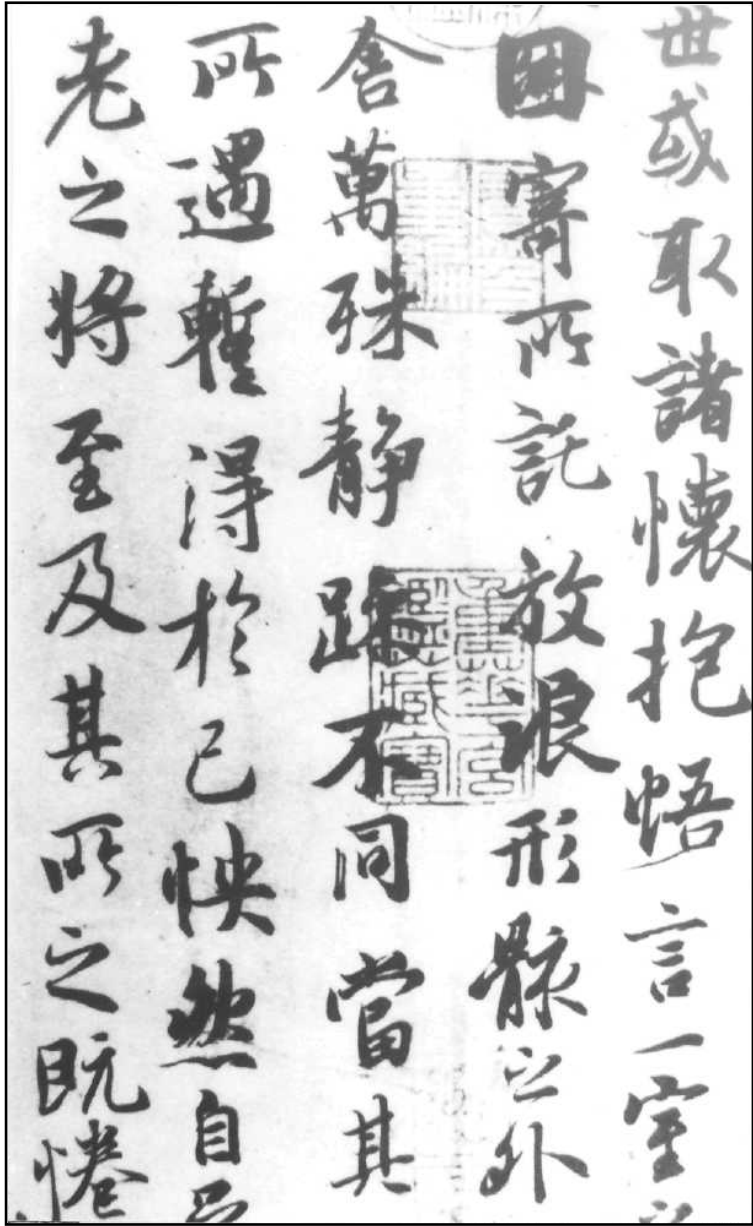




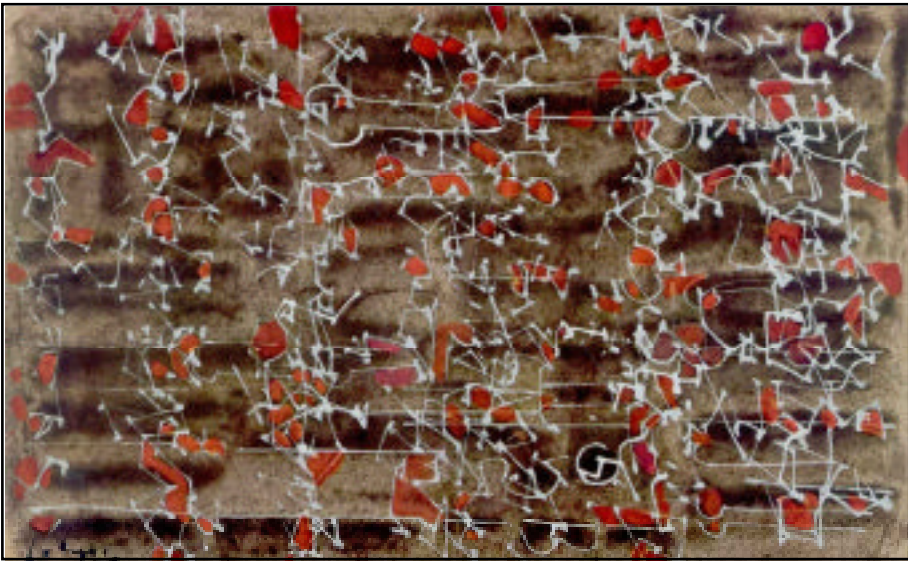

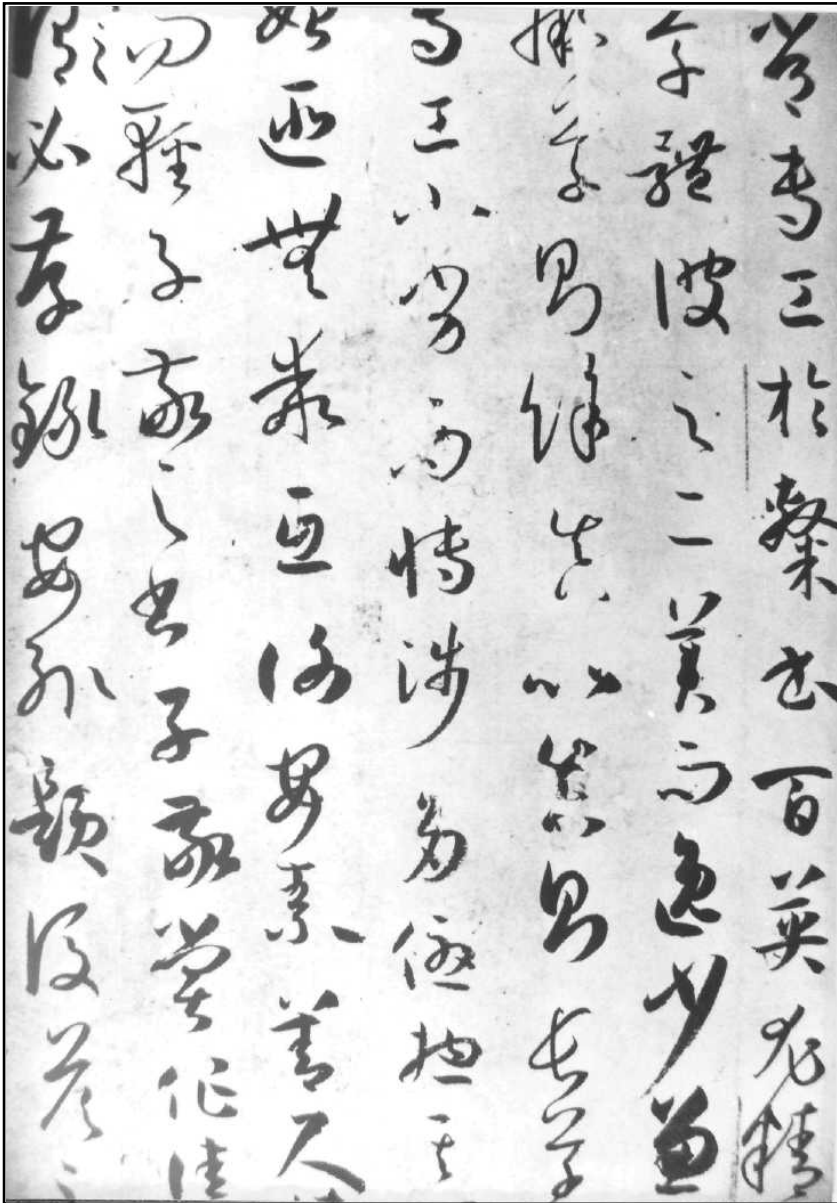

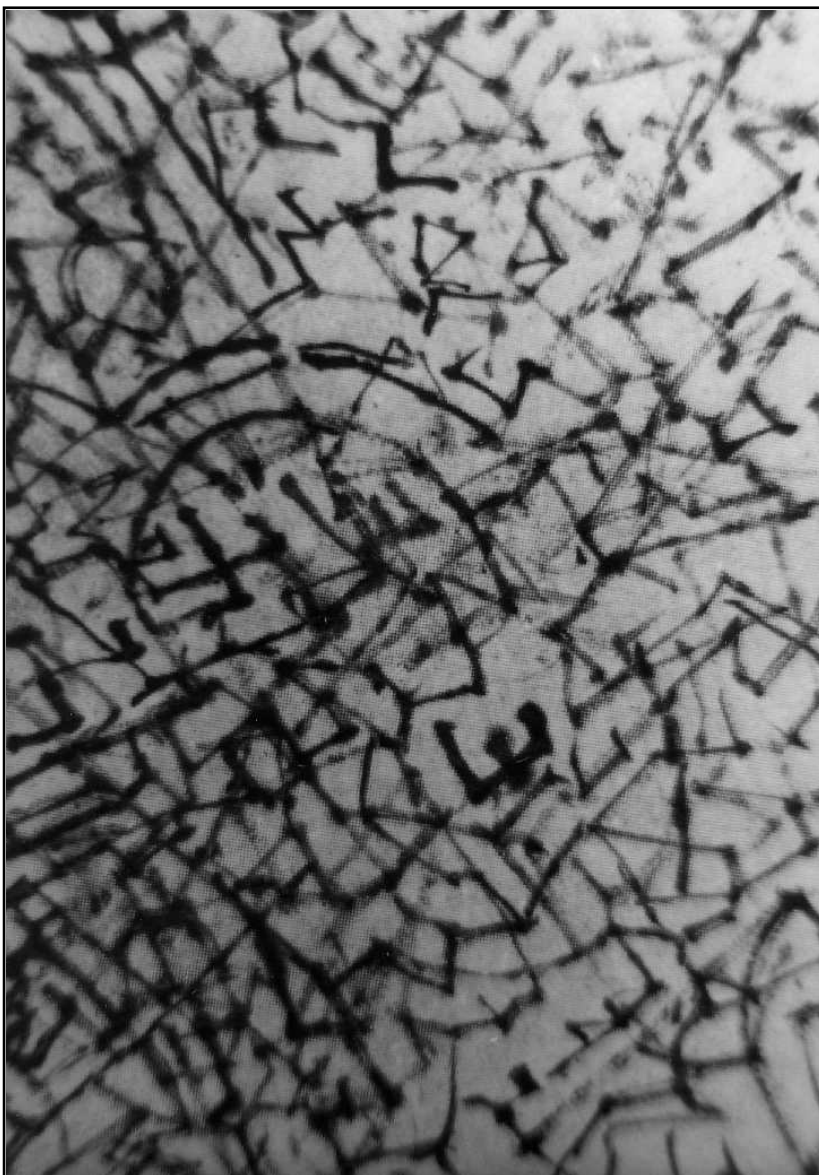

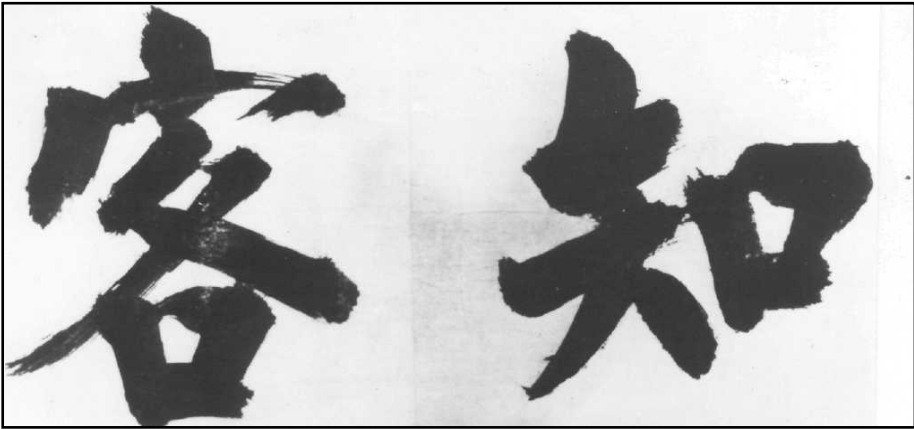

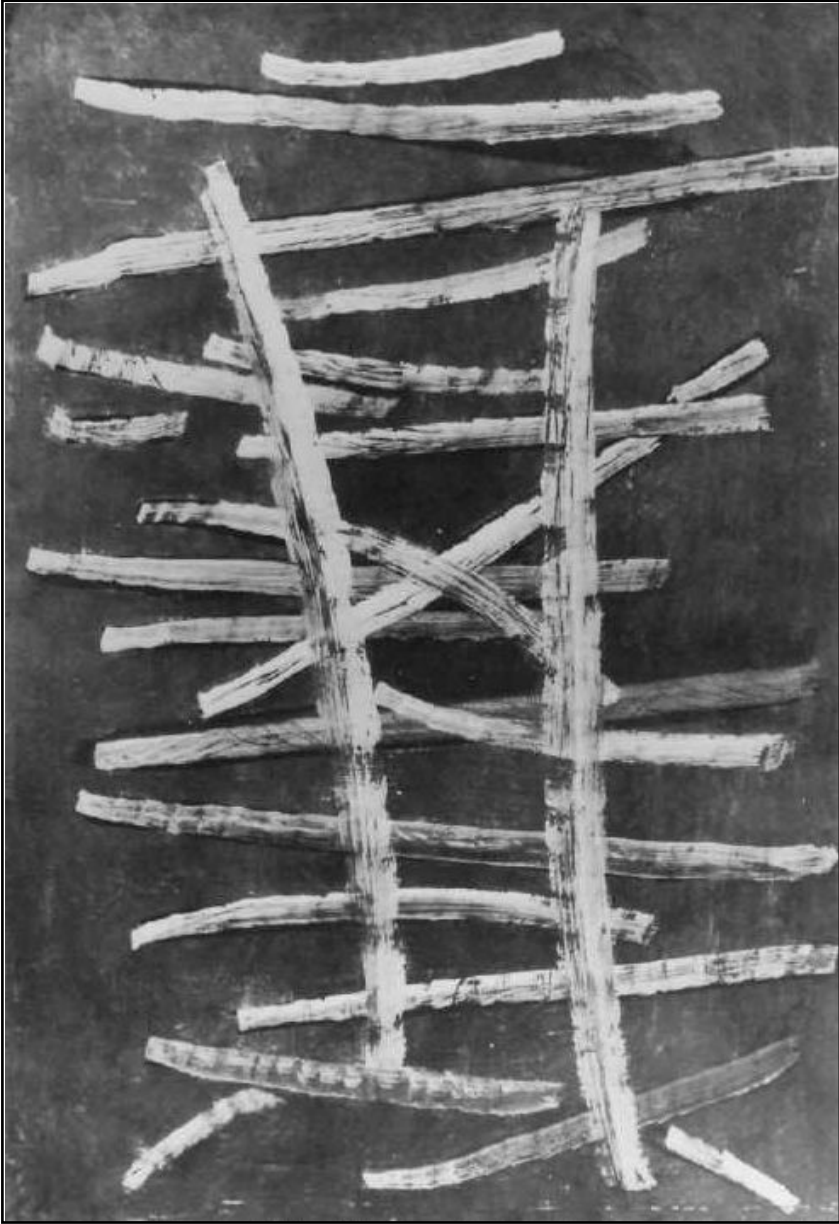

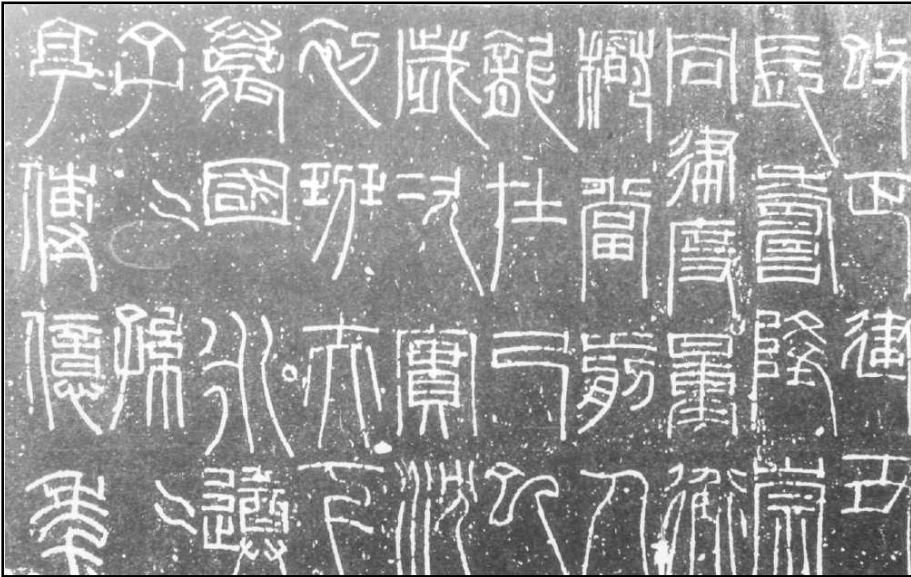

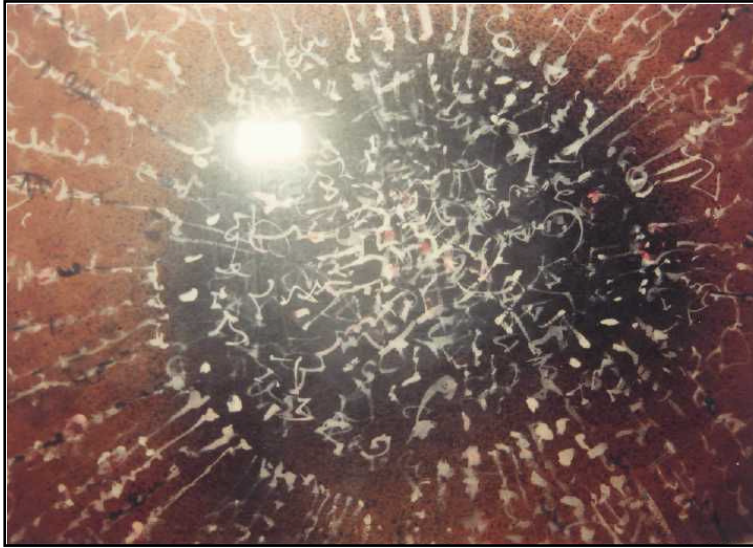
144. Emperor Hui-tsung (徽宗), Poem, Sung-Dynasty,

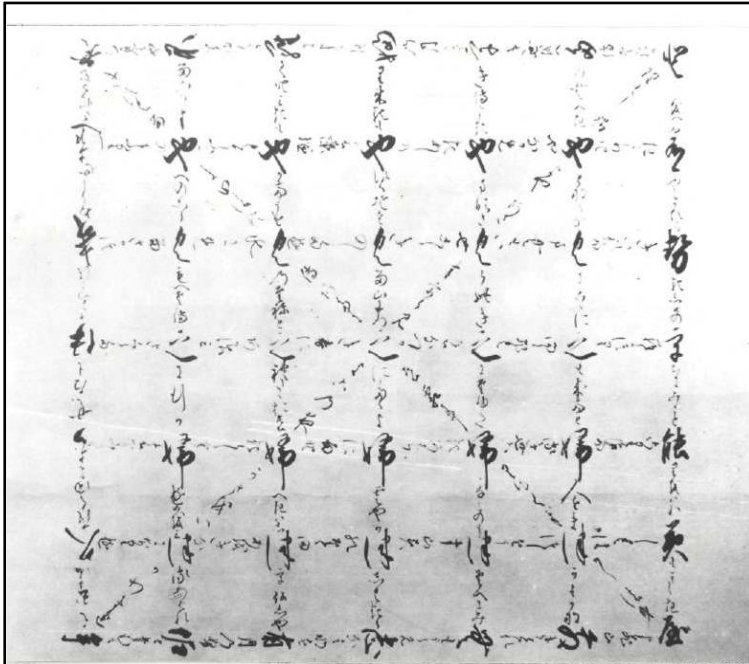

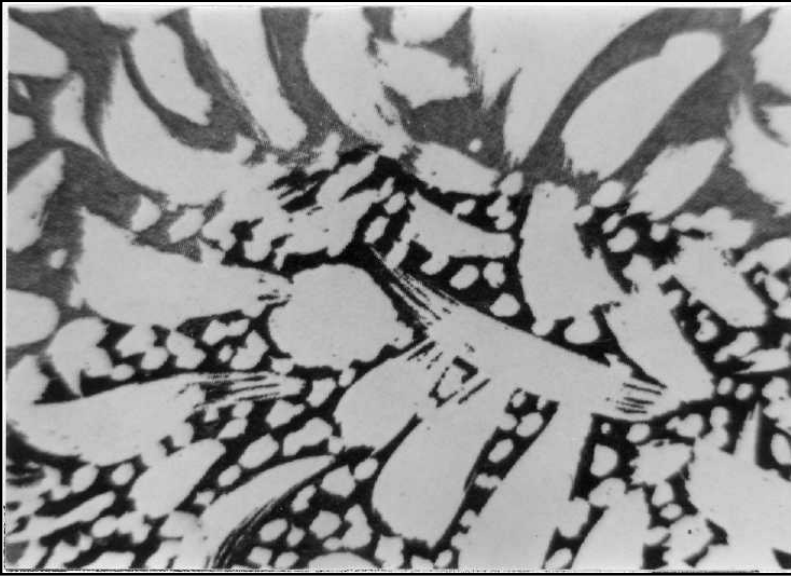

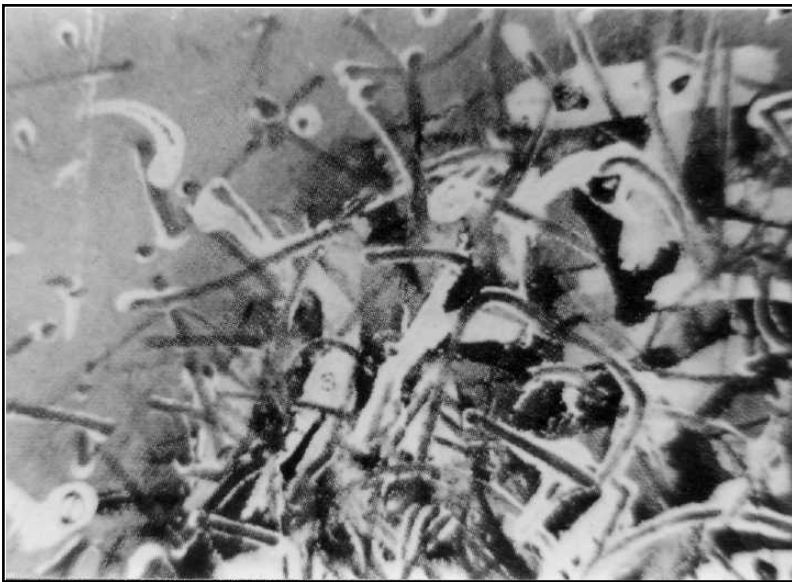

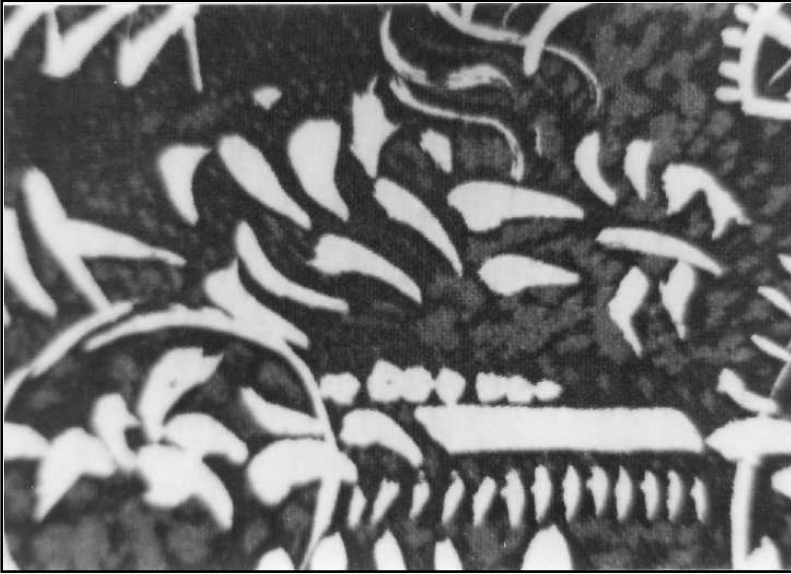


123.2 Mark Tobey, Agitated Circle, 1960, (detail)

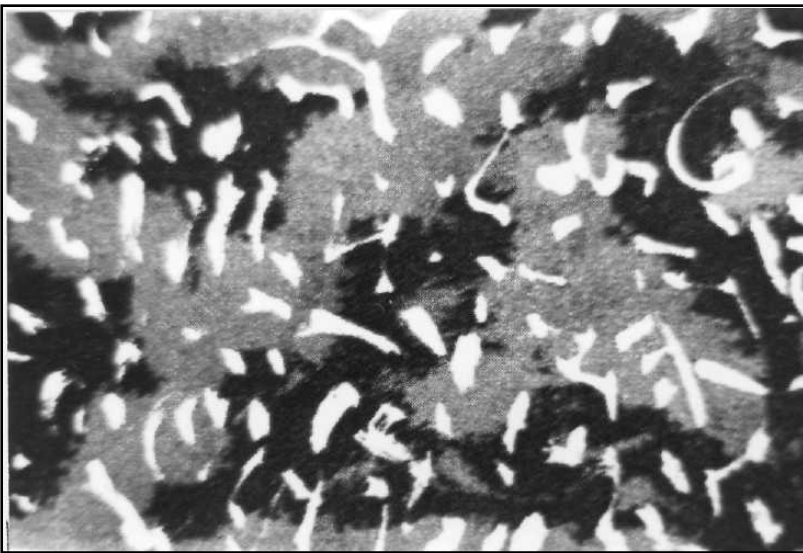

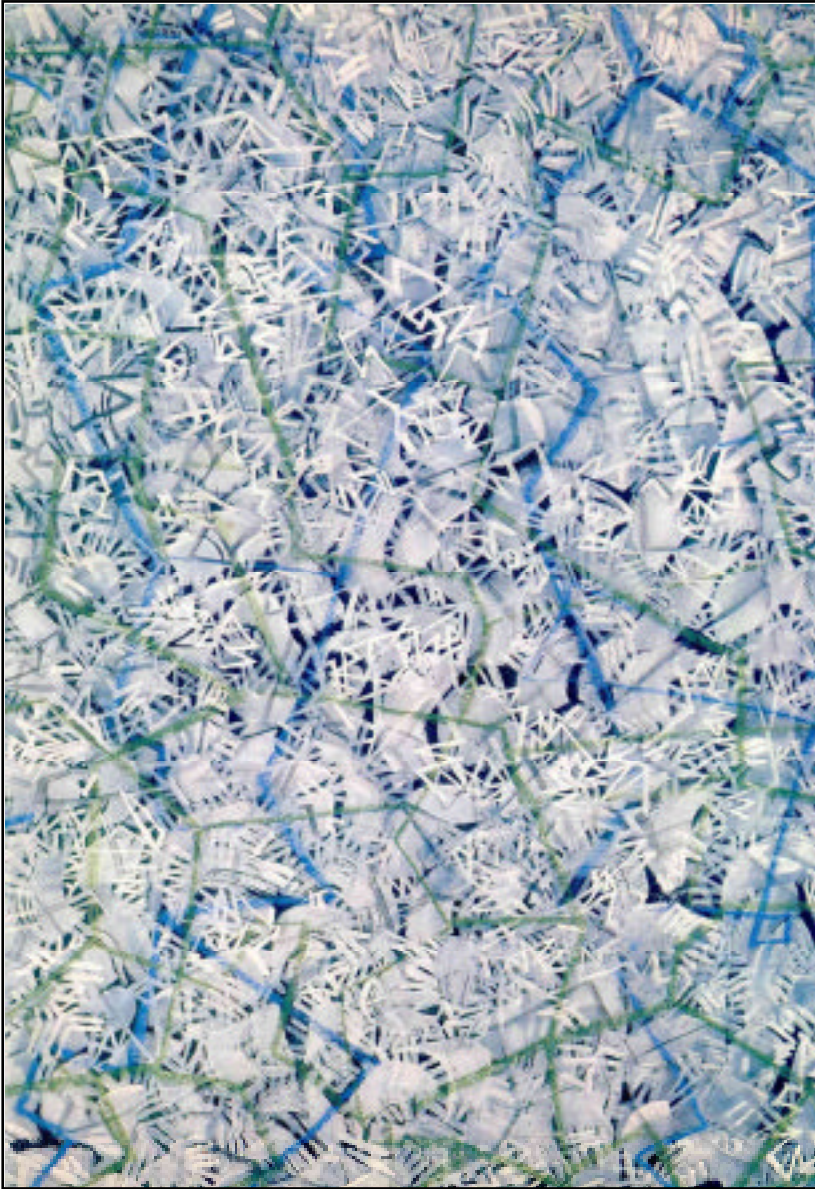
