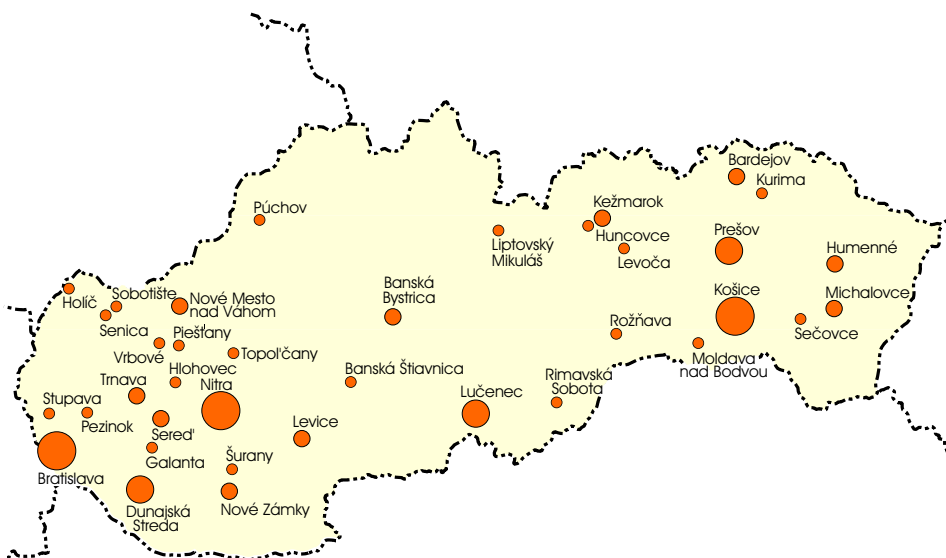

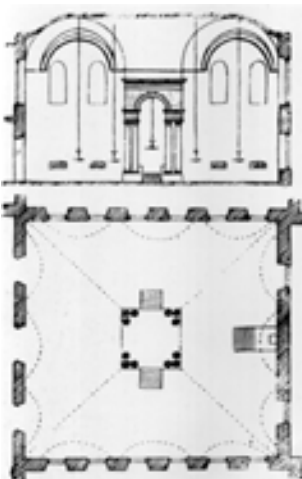

FIG. 12. Lublin, MaHarSHal Synagogue, Section and Plan; 1567, Rebuilt 1656.

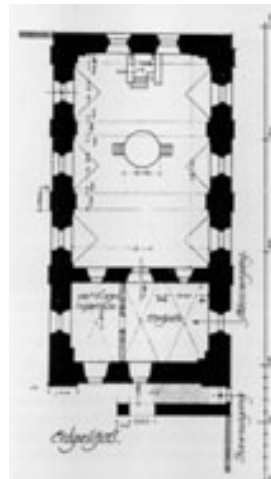

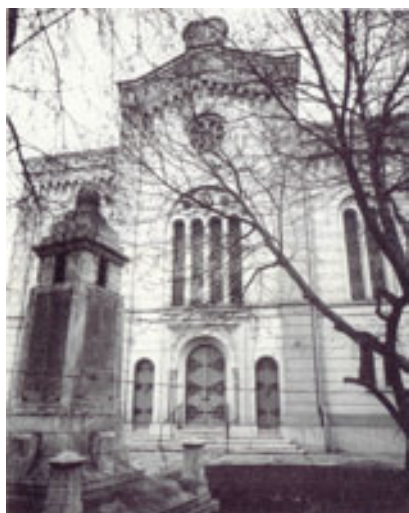

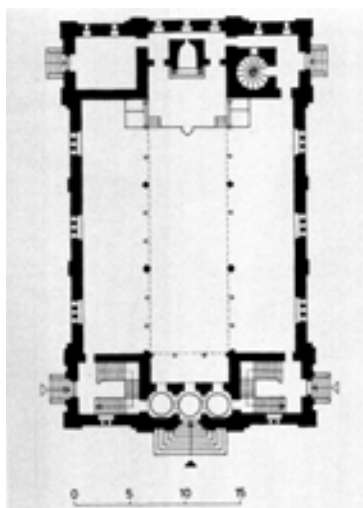

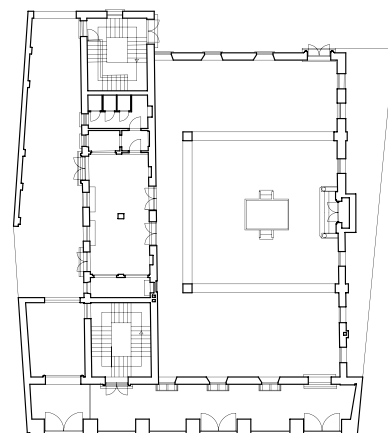

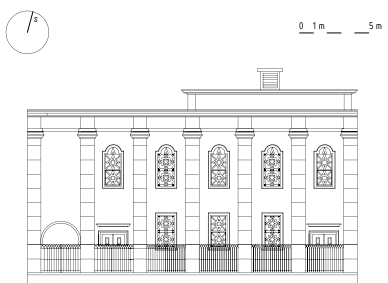


FIG. 25. Bratislava, Orthodox Synagogue, Heydukova Street, South Façade.

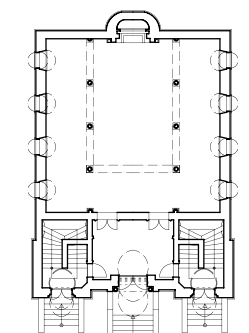

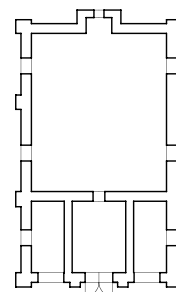

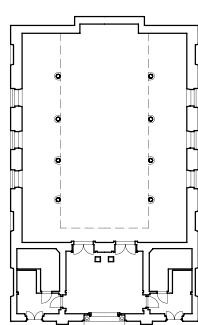
FIG. 38. Rohožník, Synagogue, North and East Façades.

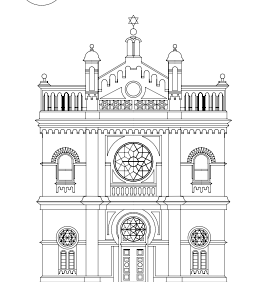

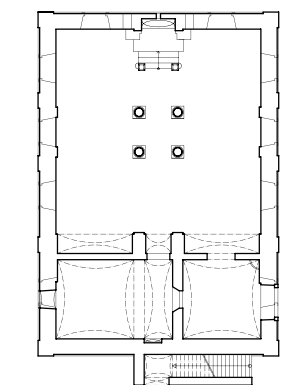

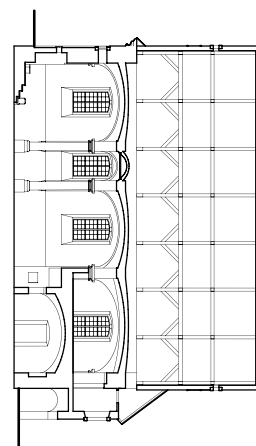

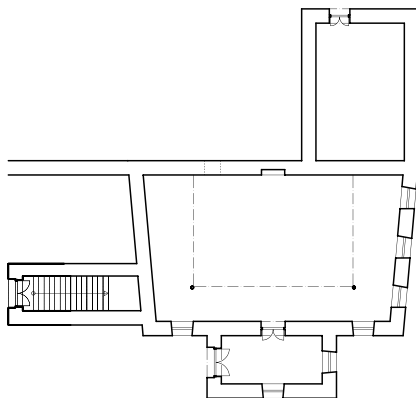
FIG. 48. Stupava, Synagogue, South and West Façades.

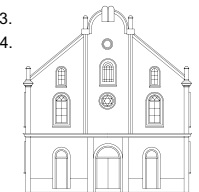
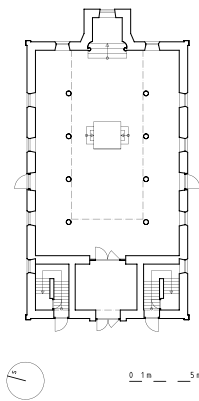

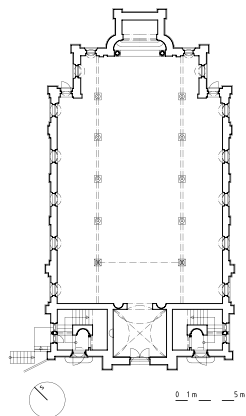

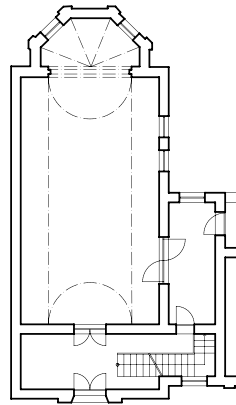

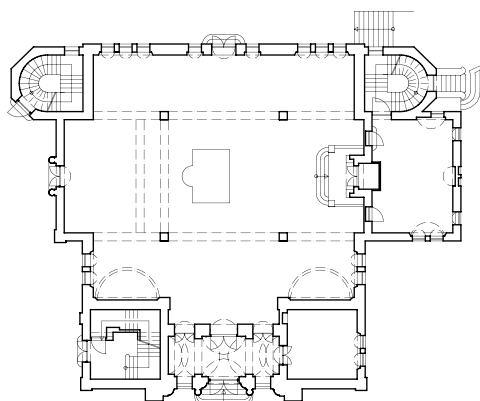

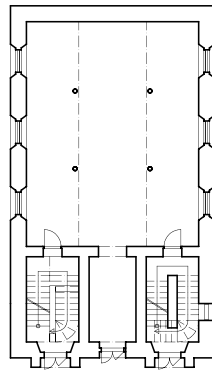

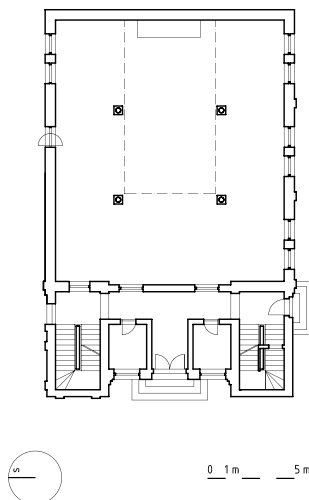


FIG. 130. FIG. 131.

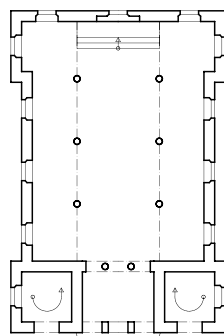

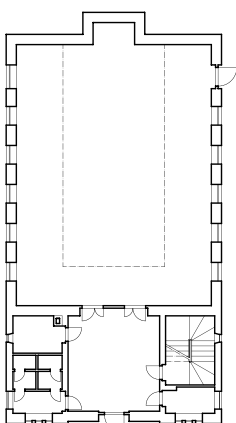

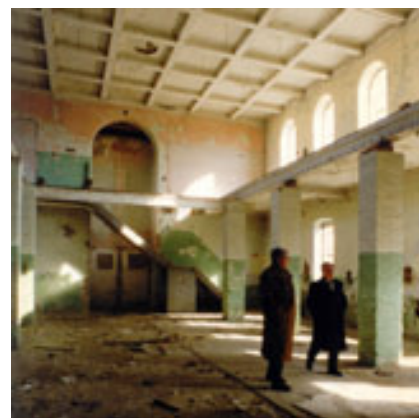

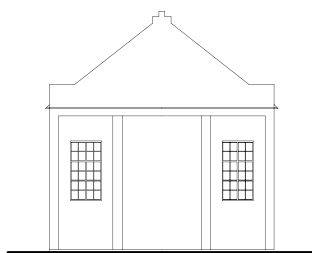

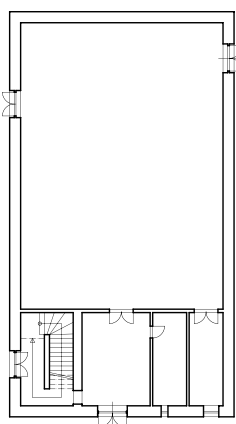

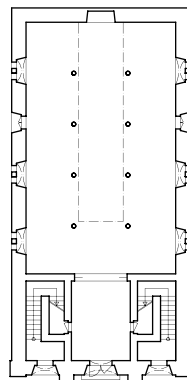

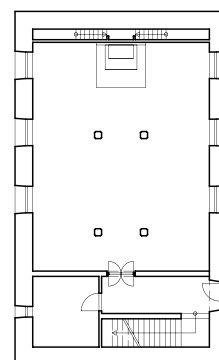

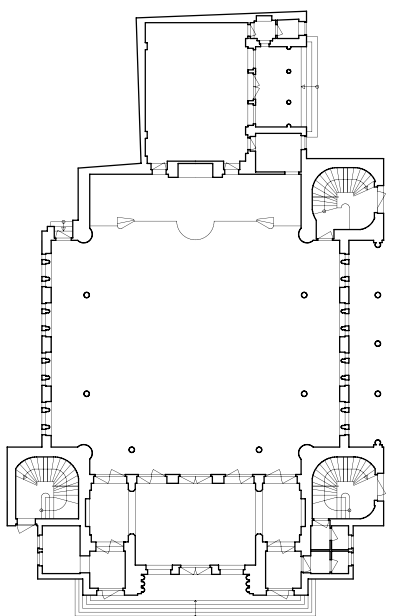

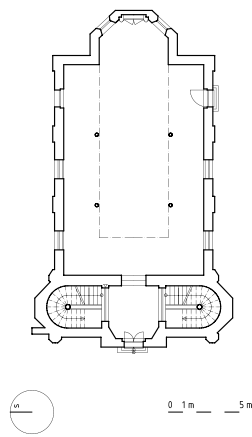


FIG. 172. Brezno, Synagogue, North and East Façades.

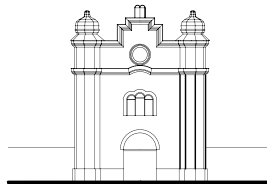
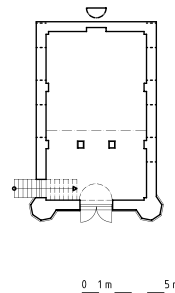

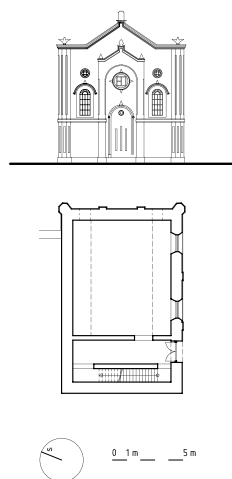


FIG. 183. FIG. 184.

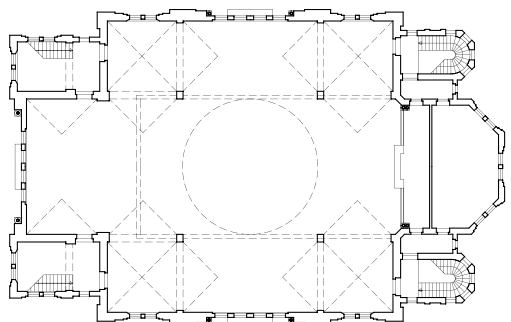

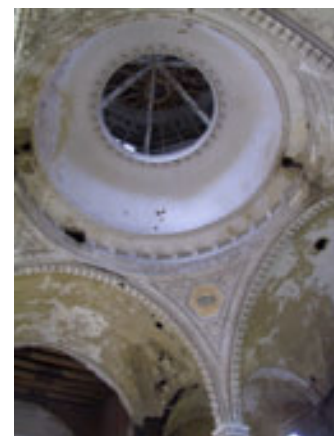

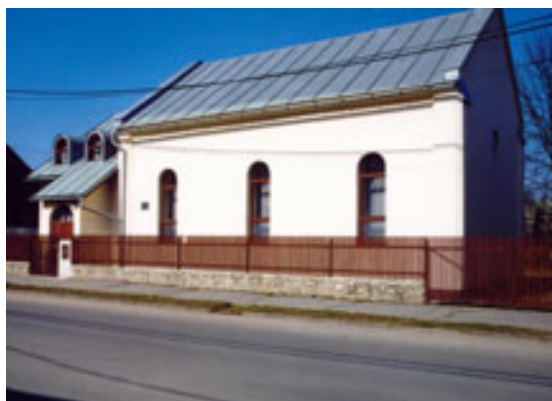

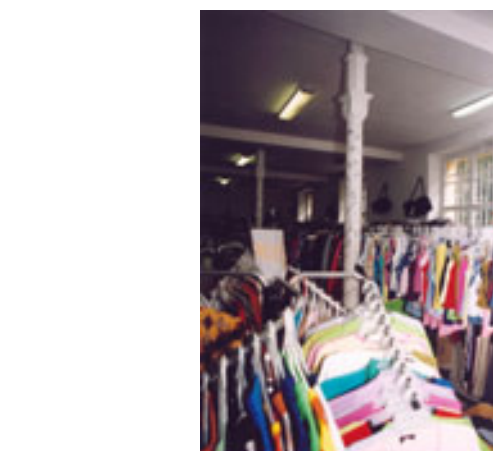

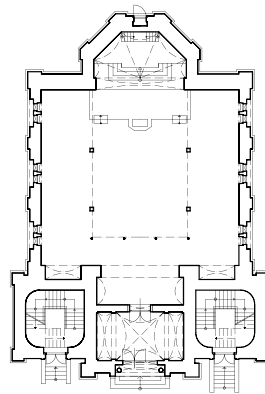
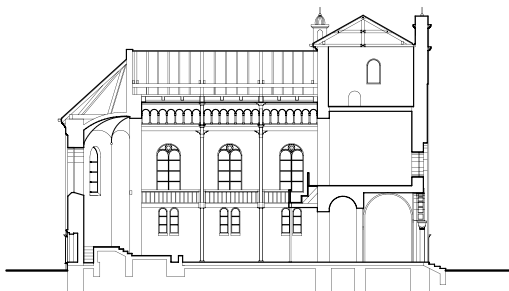
FIG. 208. Bytča, Synagogue, Section, Looking South.

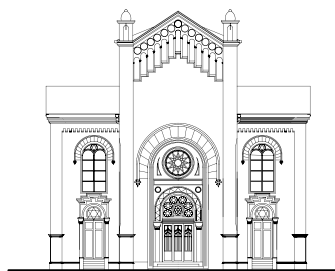

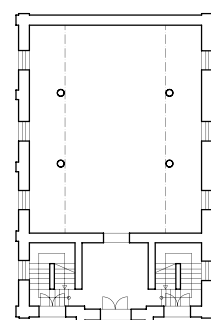
FIG. 230. Trstená, Synagogue, North and East Façades.

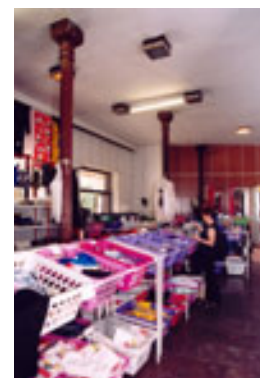

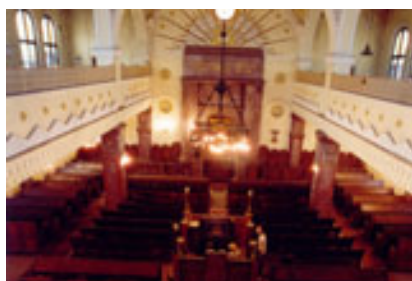

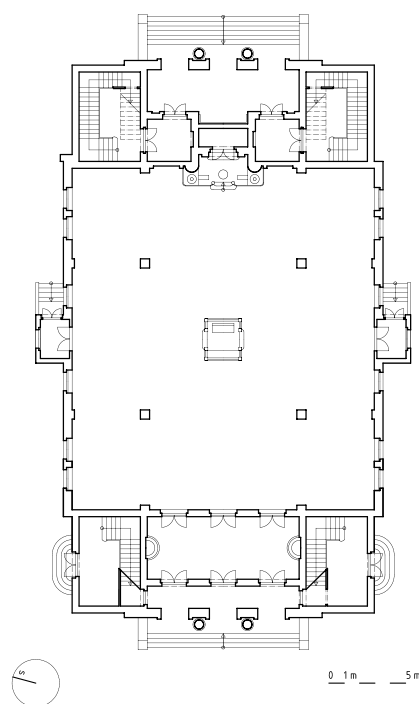

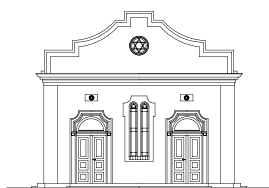

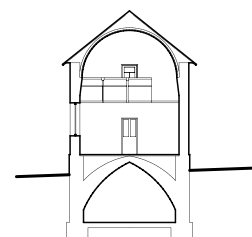


FIG. 290. Štítník, Synagogue, North and West Façades.

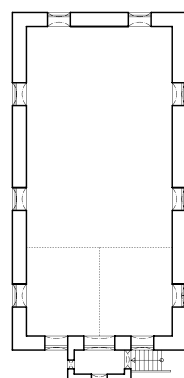
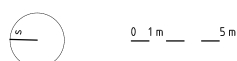

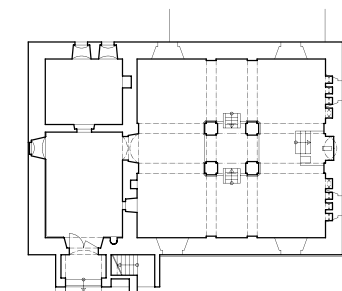
FIG. 296. Velká Ida, Synagogue, Plan.

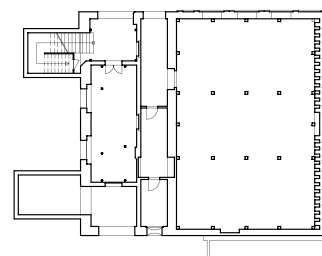

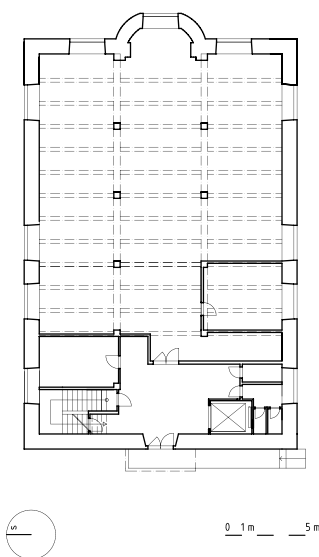

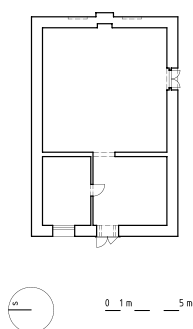

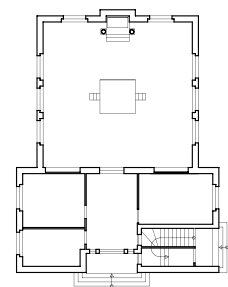
FIG. 352. Prešov, Orthodox Synagogue, North Façade.

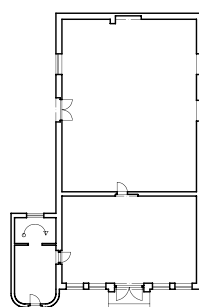
FIG. 355. Prešov, Hassidic Synagogue, South and West Façades.

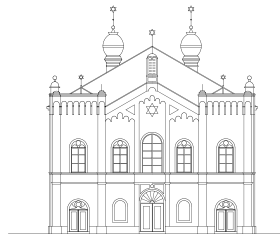

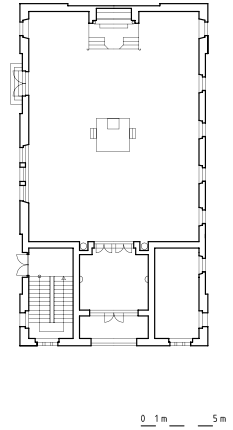

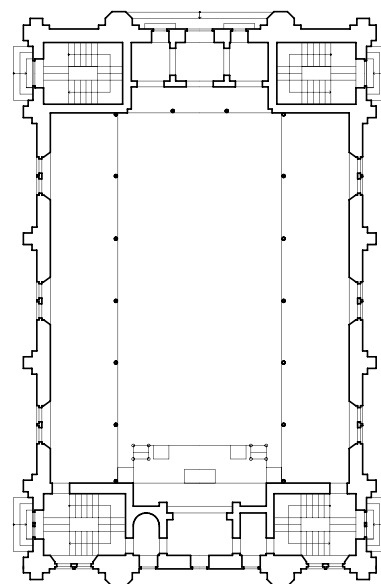

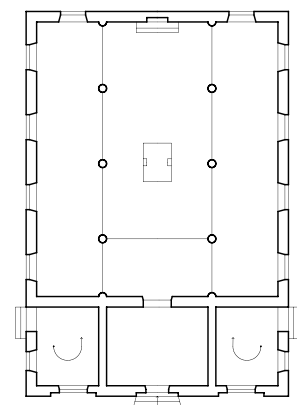

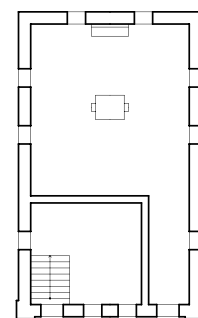

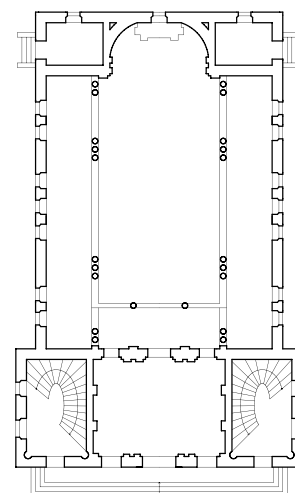

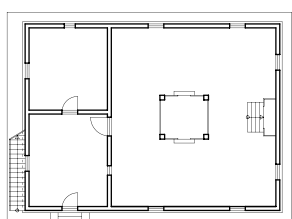

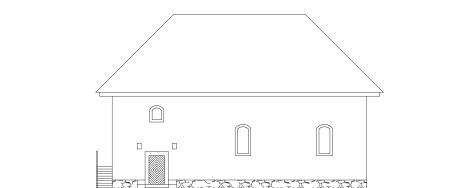

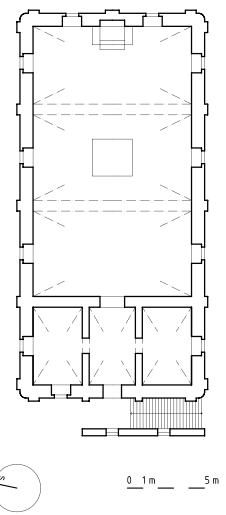

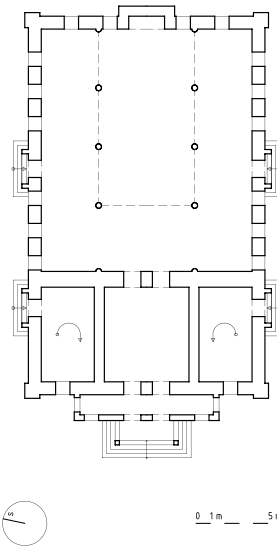
